The Penetang Juveniles got some good news Wednesday night following their 10-0 whitewash over Port McNicoll.

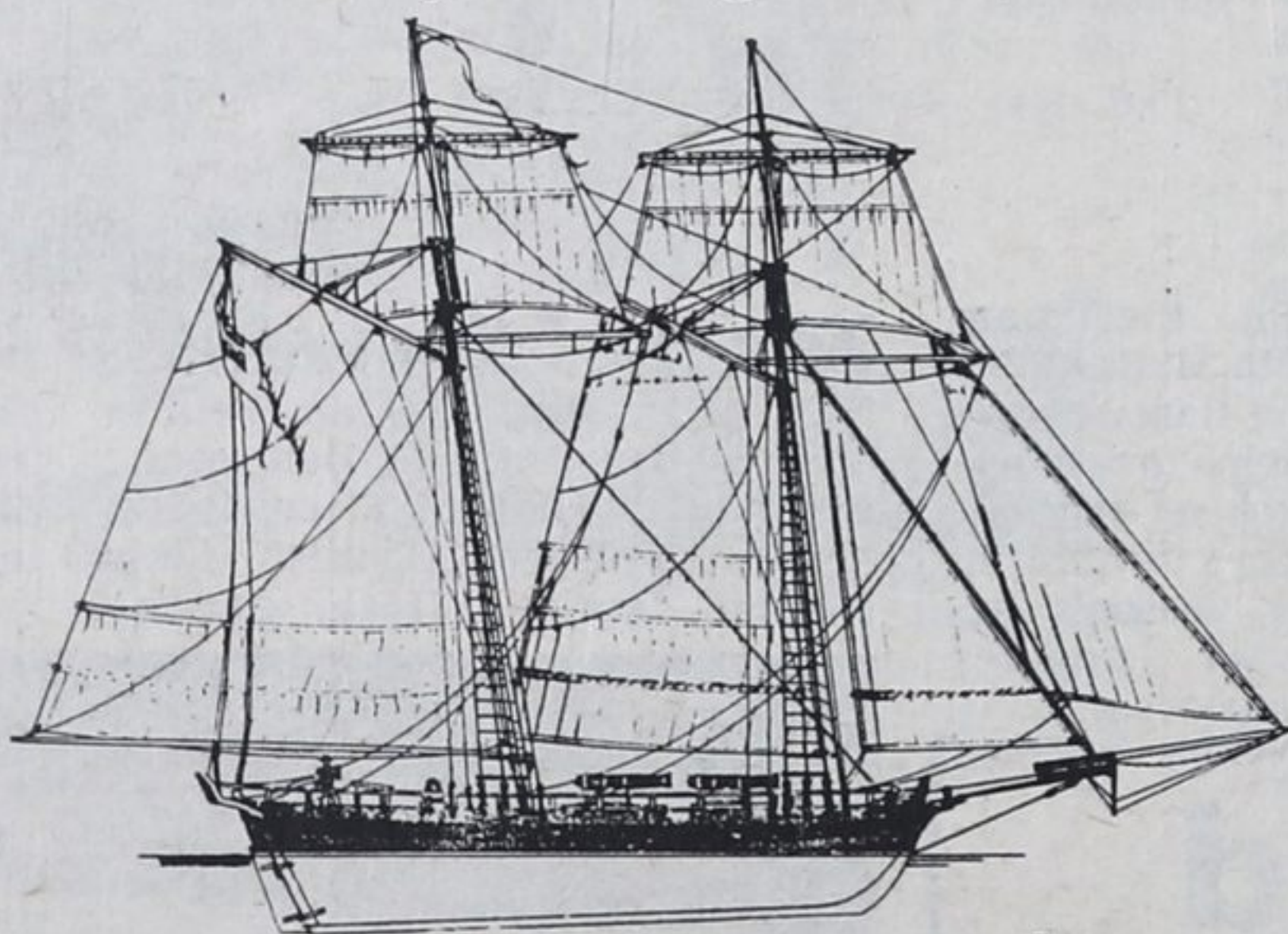
