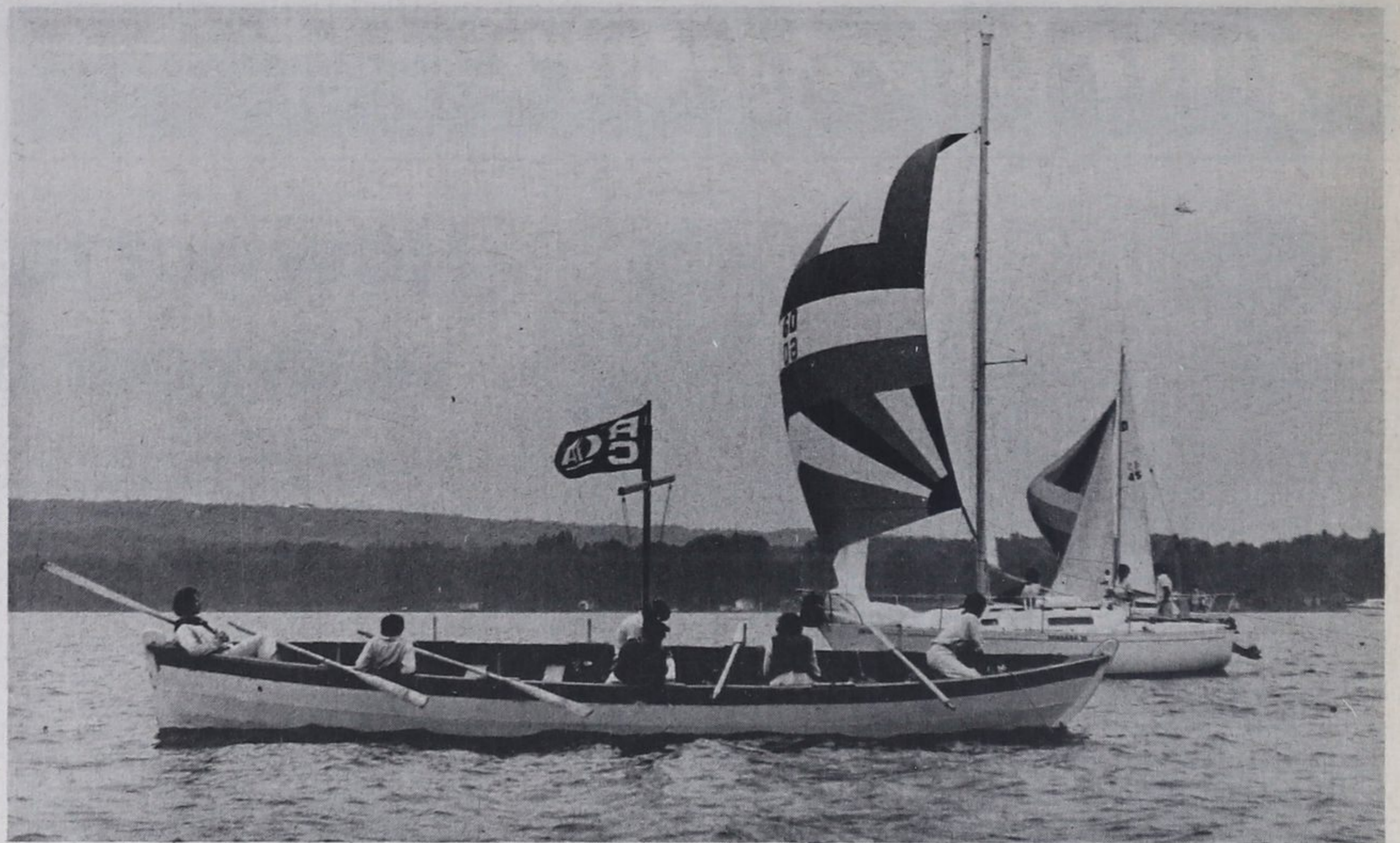

# Dupuis, Stompers set for semi-finals

With only four teams left in the senior ball hockey playoffs, the stage is set for some potentially good semi-final action.

The other three semi-finalists had an easier time of it, sweeping their respective series two games straight.

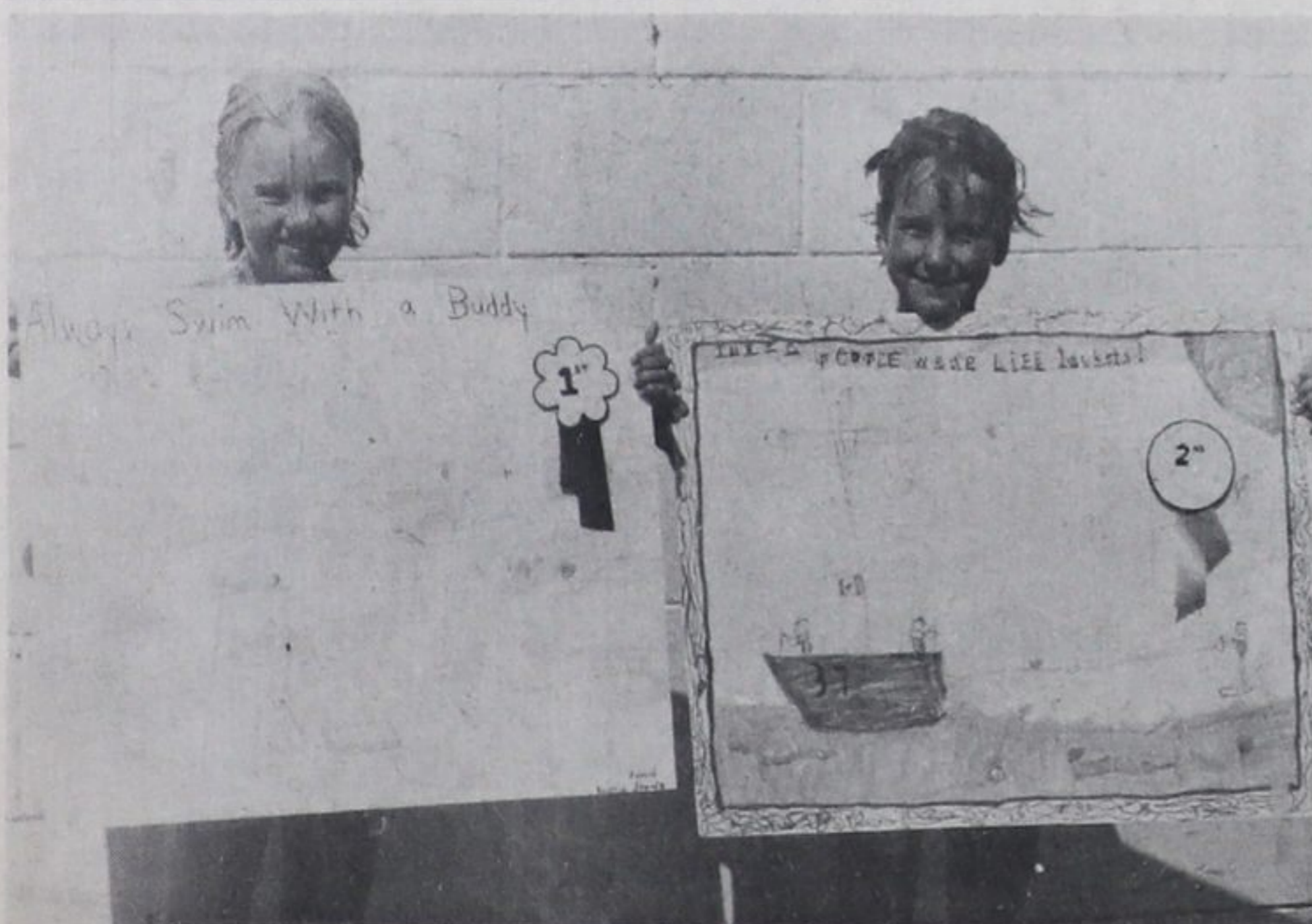
The Dupuis-Stompers series should be close, but unless the IGA Strikers fall dead, they'll be in the finals once again.

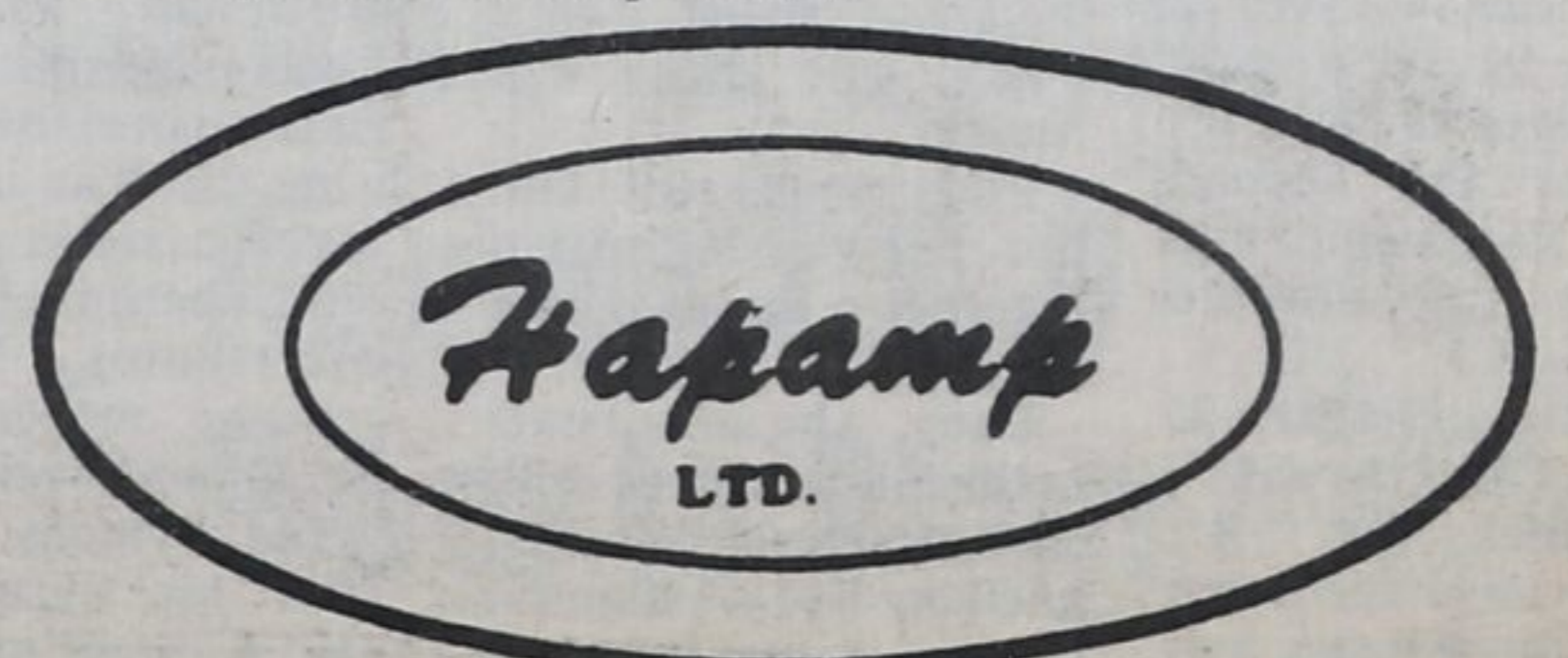
