NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD BY THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMVALE FOR APPROVAL OF A BY-LAW TO REGULATE LAND USE PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 35 OF THE PLANNING ACT (R.S.O. 1970)

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Elmvale intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 35 of The Planning Act (R.S.O. 1970), for approval of By-law No. 80-9, passed on the 18 day of August 1980. A copy of the By-law is furnished herewith. A note giving an explanation of the purpose and effect of the By-law and stating the lands affected thereby is also furnished herewith.

ANY PERSON INTERESTED MAY, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Village of Elmvale notice of objection to approval of the said By-law or part thereof giving details of all or the portion of the By-law to which you object and detailed reasons therefor and shall indicate that, if a hearing is held, the objector or an agent will attend at the hearing to support the objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the By-law may, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Village of Elmvale notice of support of approval of the said By-law, together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held, giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said By-law but, before doing so, it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the By-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent and, similarly, to any person who has filed a request for a change in the provisions of the By-law.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS will be the 18 day of September 1980.

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMVALE EXPLANATORY NOTE TO BY-LAW NO. 80-9

The following is an explanatory note to By-law No. 80-9, which amends By-law No. 74-14, as amended (the Zoning By-law of the Village of Elmvale): The Municipality has received an application to change the zoning in part of Lot 22, Registered Plan No. 397 to C to permit the expansion of floor space and outdoor parking for the existing IGA supermarket.

Schedule "A" to this By-law changes the zoning on the said lands to General Commercial (C).

This By-law becomes effective when passed by Council, subject to its approval by the Ontario Municipal Board.

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMVALE BY-LAW NO. 80-9 A BY-LAW TO AMEND ZONING BY-LAW NO. 74-14

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Elmvale deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 74-14, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Elmvale ENACTS as follows:

- Schedule "A", attached to and forming part of By-law No. 74-14, is hereby amended by changing to C the zone symbol on the lands designated "ZONE CHANGE TO C" on the attached Schedule "A" hereto.
- Schedule "A" hereto is hereby made a part of this By-law as fully and to all intents and purposes as though recited in full herein.
- This By-law shall become effective on the date hereof, subject to receiving the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
