



Mock disaster at MHC

The Penetanguishene Mental Health Centre staged a mock disaster yesterday, in the form of a simulated bombing, with possible gas leaks. The exercise went rather smoothly, considering the circumstances. There was the

occasional case of a much needed stretcher not being where it should have, but all in all, it was all handled very professionally. Taking part in the exercise were six members of the Huronia Historical Park, and about a dozen

employees of the hospital, all volunteering to act as victims of the blast. One "casualty" was reported as a result of the bombing. The Penetanguishene police department blocked

off the roads into the area, while the Penetanguishene Fire Department handled the simulation much as they would in a real emergency of this type.
