But it wasn't the kind of bull you might be thinking of. It was instead a mechanical bullthe "Honky Tonk Buckin' Bull" to be precise.

The mechanical beast, identical to the machine seen in the movie Urban Cowboy, starring John Travolta, was unveiled to the public to inaugurate the re-opening of the "Garage", now to be called the "Corral" at the hotel. And it makes the Commodore the first bar in Canada to have a bull.

The hotel's owner, Bob Monteith said he and the staff had been trying to come up with an idea for the "Garage" for several weeks and they decided with the western phase just beginning in fashion and other areas, it would be a good idea to turn the "Garage" into a western bar.

After that it was a matter of leg work. Monteith was going to contact some people at Gillies', the bar in Texas

where the movie Urban Cowboy was based, but eventually they contacted a John Sassak of Detroit, who was involved in manufacturing of the bulls in the U.S.


Arrangements

Following some negotiations, arrangements were made to purchase the Commodore's bull and moreover, Monteith entered a deal to manufacture the bulls in Canada. He is now in partnership with Bill Graham of Midland Tool and Die in modifying, strengthening and manufacturing the bulls for distribution in Canada.

But before you go rushing out to buy your own "Honky Tonk Buckin' Bull'', you should realize there is a price tag of around \$9,000.

The original bull which you'll see at the Commodore was an investment of \$11,000 due to taxes and customs duties charged when the bull was brought Penetanguishene from Detroit, Michigan.

Mr. Ross, who is retired, but still acting in a consulting role for the company and his


insurance career working in Penetanguishene area and provided service to about 700 families during his 30 years.


