## Oh! Heavenly Dog

Human actor Chevy Chase and canine actor Benji might sound like a very strange co-starring team for a movie, but this bizarre casting works very well in a comedy fantasy called *Oh Heavenly Dog*. ### Private eye

In *Oh Heavenly Dog*, Chevy Chase plays an American private investigator who operates in London, England. One evening he is laid up with a cold, but he gets a phone call from his secretary.

She tells him that a man wanted to see him about undertaking a case, and he said it was urgent. So Chase goes into his office that night to meet his new client. The guy says that he wants to buy protection for a young lady.

Chase undertakes the case, and ends up getting murdered. It has been a frame-up. He awakens in the afterlife at a waystation, but he is told that before he can go on he will have to prove his worth by taking on an assignment. The assignment is for him to go back to earth and solve his murder.

The only problem is that the only body that is available for him to go back in is that of a small dog. This is where Benji's role enters the picture.

### Misadventures

Numerous complications and misadventures occur when the detective returns to earth to try to find his murderer. *Oh Heavenly Dog* is both an amusing comedy and a whimsical fantasy, in the same style as the hit Warren Beatty film *Heaven Can Wait*. In addition, *Oh Heavenly Dog* could also be classified as a whodunit murder mystery.

Chevy Chase is a former television comedian, best remembered as a regular on the "Saturday Night Live" Show.

He made a successful transition to motion pictures two years ago with *Foul Play* in which he co-starred with Goldie Hawn.
