Epirotiki Lines expanding its cruises

Epirotiki Lines is expanding its cruise to Egypt and Israel introduced in 1980.

In 1981 the series of seven day Mediterranean Odyssey cruises embarks from Piraeus on Feb. 16 and runs through Nov. 23 for a total of 41 sailings. Ten cruises have been added for the new year.

A call in Turkey is being added to the itinerary, which already includes Israel, Egypt and the Greek Islands. This now makes the cruise a four country venture, but with the convenience that no visas are required by participants. The ship gets a blanket visa to cover all passengers as a group.

The cruise is being operated by the MTS Jupiter, a vessel of 9,000 tons. Rates for this four country Mediterranean Odyssey cruise range from \$675 US per person sharing a cabin for three or four to \$1,640 for superior accommodation.

Carousel Tours to Las Vegas

Carousel Tours has been appointed the exclusive wholesaler for Republic Airlines to Las Vegas using Toronto as a gateway.

At present, Republic Airlines is the only scheduled airline offering direct, one stop service to and from Las Vegas with the following flight times. Departing Toronto at 7:15 a.m. arriving in Las Vegas at 9:55 a.m.

Departing Las Vegas 1:40 p.m. arrive Toronto 10:05 p.m.

You will not have to deplane going or on the return and will be offered two meals on the flight. Carousel will be using 727 service on a daily basis and will be offering three, four and



seven night packages at the following hotels, Mini-Price Hotel, Golden Nugget, Frontier Hotel, Flamingo Hilton, Imperial Palace, Desert Inn, MGM Grand, and Caesar's Palace.

On Florida's Pinellas Suncoast, a variety of boats sail out on special cruises to give visitors a different view of the vacation area. Narrated sightseeing cruises, casual lunch cruises, moonlight cruises and even one with a pirate captain aboard are available in the eight Gulf of Mexico communities of Clearwater Beach, Dunedin, Holiday Isles, Madeira Beach, St. Pete's Beach, St. Petersburg, Treasure Island or Tarpon Springs.

The Gulf of Mexico is on the west, Tampa Bay on the east and Boca Ciega Bay and the Intracoastal Waterway ribbon through several communities in the Pinellas Suncoast area.

One of the romantic cruises is aboard the Tonga, the 72 foot sailing yacht which belonged to the late movie idol Errol Flynn.

Midland lucky: former chief librarian
