New budget procedure for Harbour

At Monday night's meeting of Victoria Harbour council, a new approach was adopted to setting up a budget for the next year of operation.

Instead of the council making up a budget, the committees in each

division will be asked to submit a budget.

For this purpose, the council discussed a possible guideline that committees may follow when making up their yearly financial arrangements.

Jackson feels that such a change in procedure will involve more people in the decision making.

He foresees a lot of problems but feels that they will be ironed out soon afterward.

Further amendments to the budgetary process include a new purchasing procedure.

It's basically tentative at the moment but the council agreed in general that purchase order numbers will be used.

People on committees also are affected as to their buying power with any purchase to \$50 being up to the discretion of the buyer concerning where that item is bought.

From \$50-\$200, a phone or verbal quote is necessary and \$200 up to \$1500 requires a written quote.

Any purchase over \$1500 must be tendered.

Any bids taken in but not accepted will be kept on file for future reference.

A more detailed

outline of the changes will be discussed at the next meeting Jan. 12 with any changes being made then.
