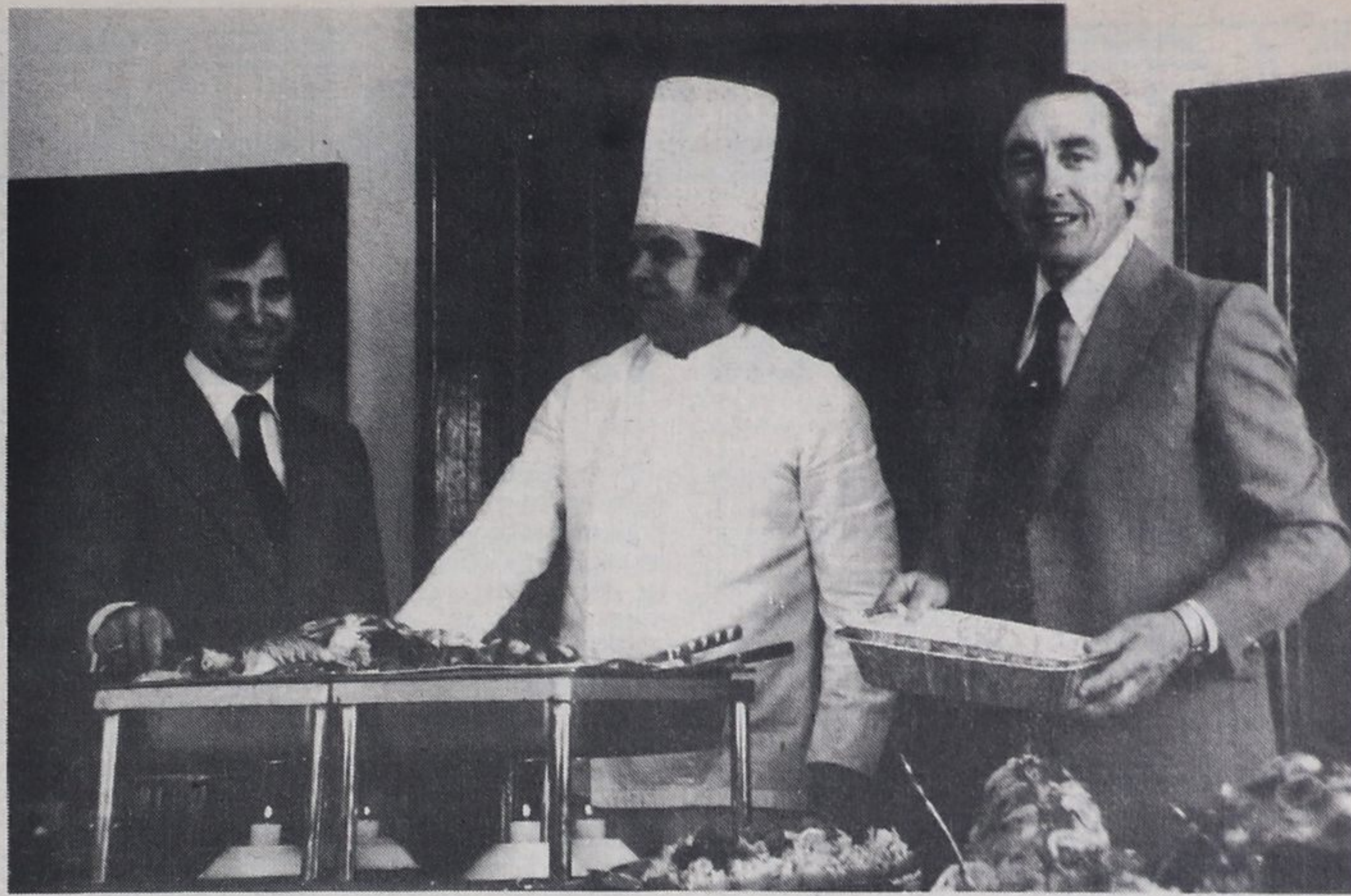




**Say cheese!**

**\$100 for boarding, but not a fine**

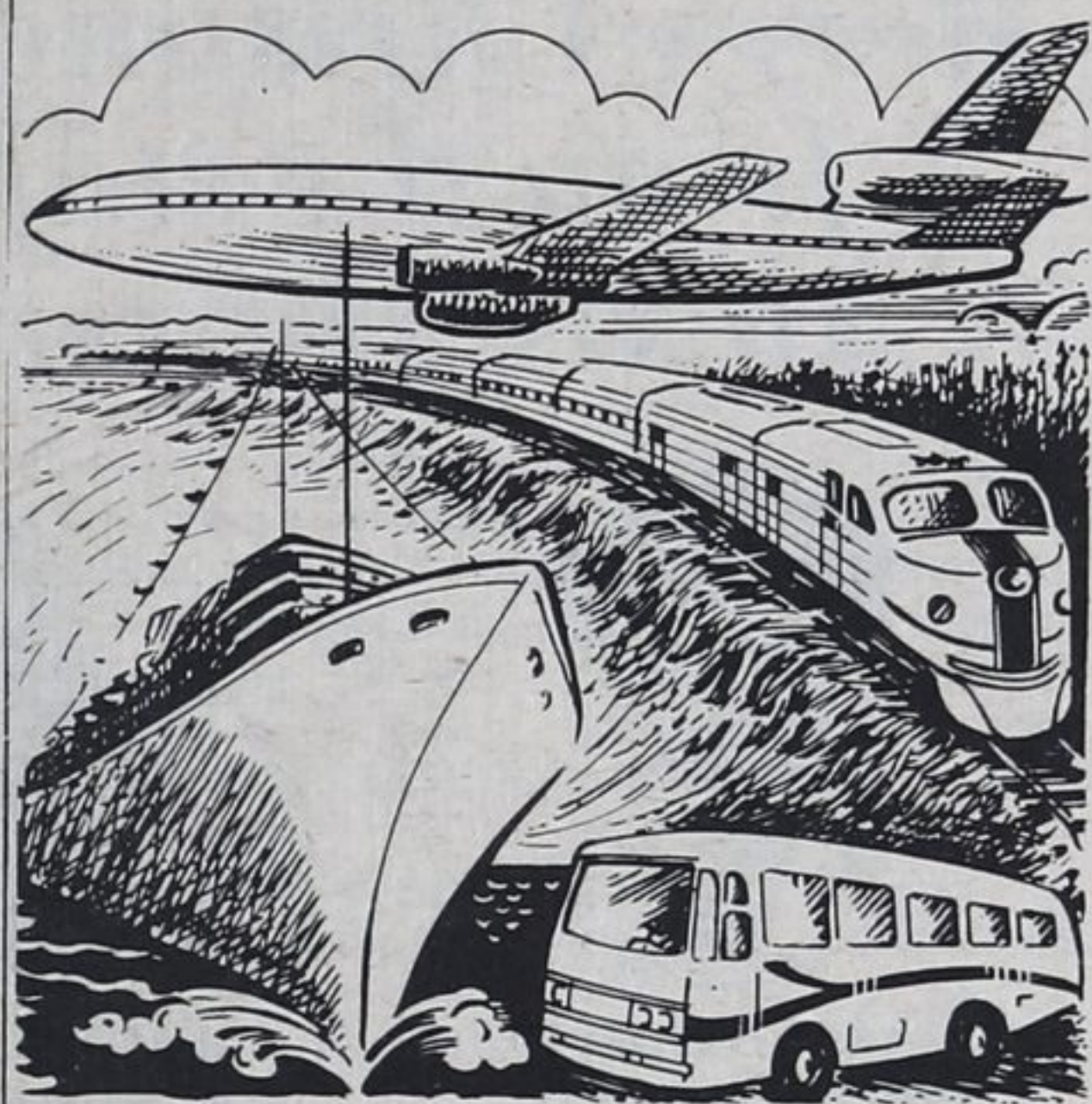
The hockey rink in Waubaushene Arena is operating with some new rink boards thanks to the combined efforts of many concerned citizens of Waubaushene and surrounding area.

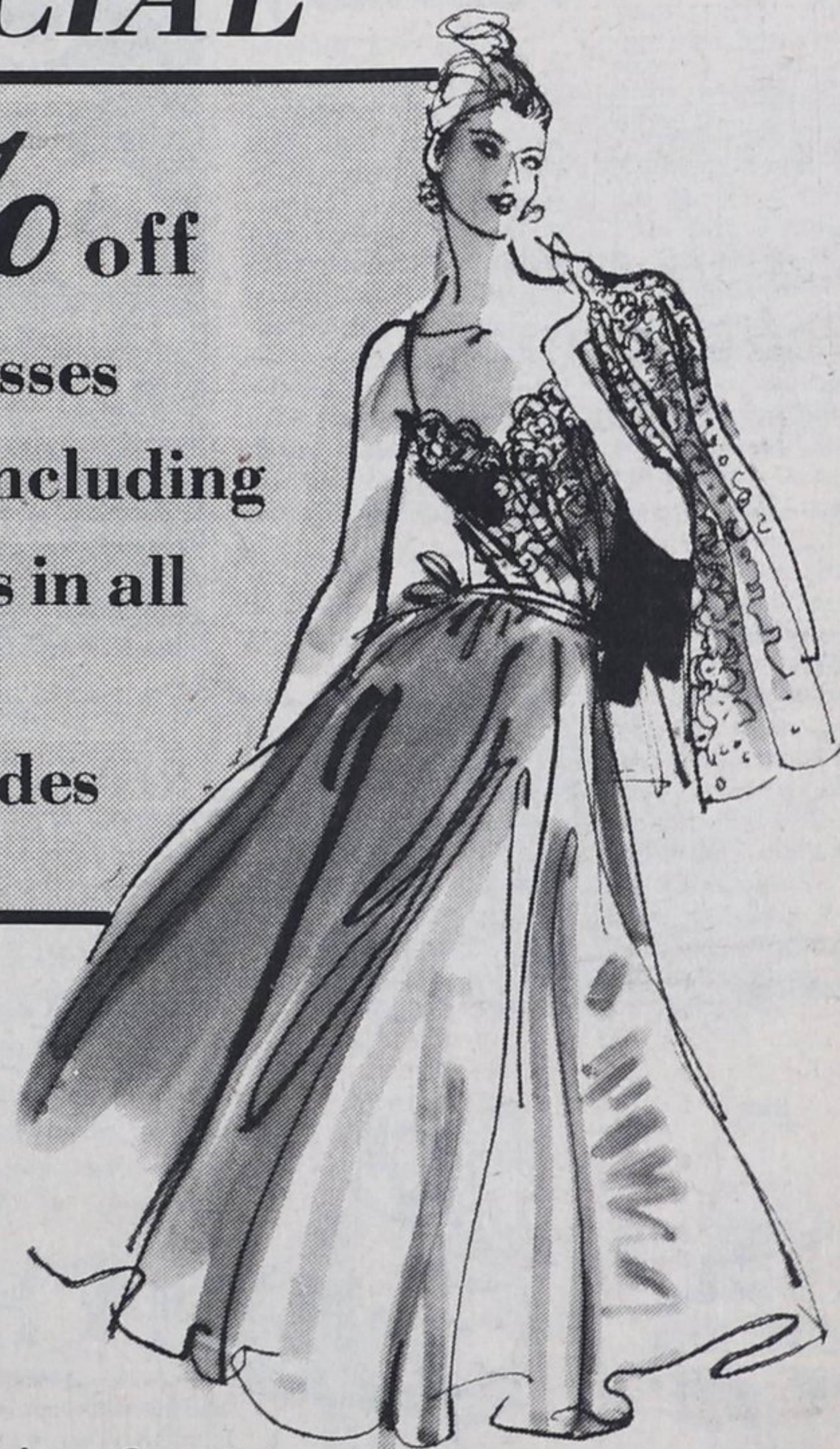
