Phillip Chouinor

The funeral service for Phillip Chouinor, who died suddenly in his 45th year in Huronia

District Hospital, on Dec. 26, 1980, was held on Dec. 29, 1980. Born in Papineau

Township, Ontario, and married in Sudbury on Sept. 12, 1970, he lived for the last six years in

this area. He was employed by Kindred Industries of Midland. He lived previously in Sudbury.

Surviving him are his wife, Lorraine (Lavallee) Chouinor, son Phillip Jr., and daughter Nicole, all of 99 Yeo Street, Penetanguishene.
