A built-in electronic flash extends your capabilities in low-light conditions requiring illumination, and it also can help remove shadows from a subject's face in bright sunlight.

Photo experts offer the following tips for the wedding day instant picture-taker:

- Move in close and compose the shot by filling the frame with the subject's image.

- Hold the camera steady and squeeze the shutter gently to avoid movement.

- Look for people who are busy talking, laughing, dancing, and doing something naturally. People who are relaxed will have more natural expressions than those who are posing for a picture.

- Keep the instant camera and supply of film nearby to capture such events as friends laughing or placing streamers and signs on the couple's car that often result in ideal pictures.

Following these simple steps will help you obtain quality pictures.

Within minutes, you will be able to share the photos with your friends to help bring even more excitement to an already joyous occasion.
