Farm Roundup

There is a deadline for claiming the interest subsidy on farm operating credit over the period April 1, 1980 - Dec. 31, 1980. All applications must be submitted by March 31, 1981.

Application forms may be picked up at the Agricultural Office. It is necessary to have the lending institution certify the form which then should be mailed to the Rural Development Branch, Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food, Parliament Buildings, Toronto.

The subsidy amounts to 3 per cent on short term working capital that is borrowed above 12 per cent annual interest rate.

The maximum amount borrowed funds on which a subsidy is available is \$75,000.

Farmers owning than 75 per cent of their farming assets do not qualify.

Dairy Herd Health Workshop
