## Memorial stone in place

There were no spectators on hand Monday morning for the placement of a memorial stone at Elmvale Presbyterian Cemetery as none had been invited.

Instead three men from Anderson Monuments wrestled the high stone into place with the help of a

lift and settled the dedication on its final resting place.

The stone was put in place to commemorate the donation of approximately 15 acres of land by the Ritchie ancestors some 115 years ago. At that time John and Thomas Ritchie gave to the Presbyterian Church in

Elmvale, a corner off each of their farms for use as a community cemetery.

The date was 1864. The church Cemetery Committee recently decided a dedication was in order, and had a stone measuring seven feet by three and a half feet and spanning 10 inches in width, carved

for the land.

Monday the stone was delivered and set in place on a corner of the cemetery property, ready for the landscaping that will add beauty to its placement.

The acreage is now used for interdenominational burials and will be appropriately marked from this day on.

## OPP Report

A case of mischief resulting in over \$500 worth of damage last week highlighted reports from Elmvale OPP.

Police say a car owned by Robert Kennv of Elmvale

had its fender damaged to the tune of \$250, windshield smashed for \$200 and lag nut covers removed for \$28 total.

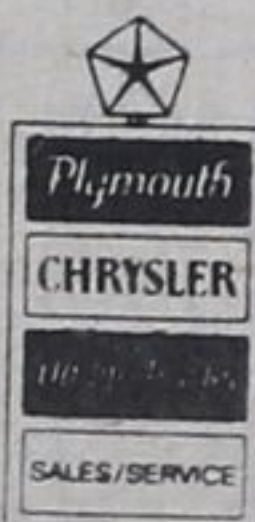
