ONTARIO GOVERNMENT NOTICE

THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AND HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT ACT PUBLIC NOTICE

IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Section 33 of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act (R.S.O. 1970, chap. 201 and amendments thereto) the Lieutenant Governor in Council did designate portions of an existing King's Highway known as Highway 27 and Highway 93, as a Controlled-Access Highway. The effective dates of the designation as a Controlled-Access Highway were January 22, 1981 for Highway 27, and January 29, 1981 for Highway 93. The portions of Controlled-Access Highway, having a right-of-way of approximately 120 feet to 160 feet in width, are located in:

1. Township of Tiny

Being part of Penetanguishene Road as travelled in Lots 80 to 92 and in Lots 95 to 101, all in Concession 1, west of Penetanguishene Road;

2. Township of Tay

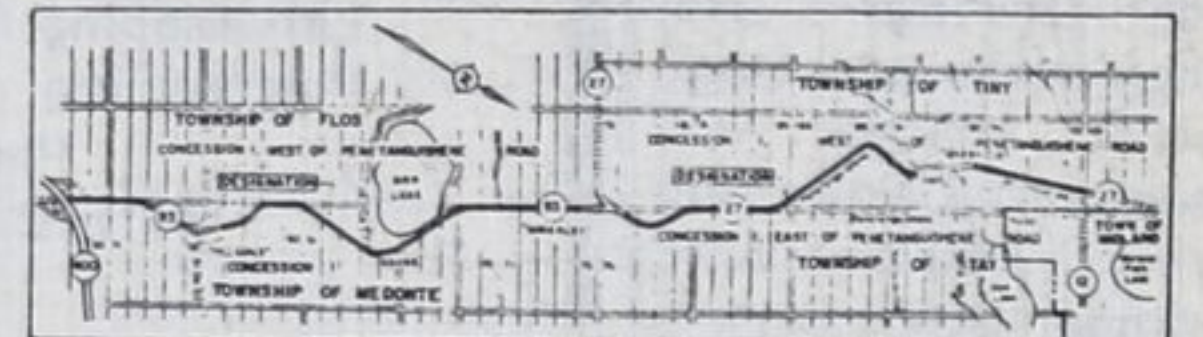
Being part of Penetanguishene Road as travelled in Lots 76 to 84, Concession 1, east of Penetanguishene Road;

3. Township of Flos

Being part of Penetanguishene Road as travelled in Lots 48 to 52, Lots 59 to 60, and in Lots 69 to 75, all in Concession 1, west of Penetanguishene Road;

4. Township of Medonte

Being part of Penetanguishene Road as travelled in Lots 48 to 70 and in Lots 72 to 75, all in Concession 1; as shown hereunder:



Order in Council numbered OC-115/81 designating portions of Highway 27 as a Controlled-Access Highway together with the Ministry of Transportation and Communications plan P-1834-157 was registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Simcoe as number 731634 and published in the Ontario Gazette on February 14, 1981.

Order in Council numbered OC-261/81 designating portions of Highway 93 as a Controlled-Access Highway together with the Ministry of Transportation and Communications Plan P-2431-20 was registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Simcoe as number 731635 and published in the Ontario Gazette on March 7, 1981.
