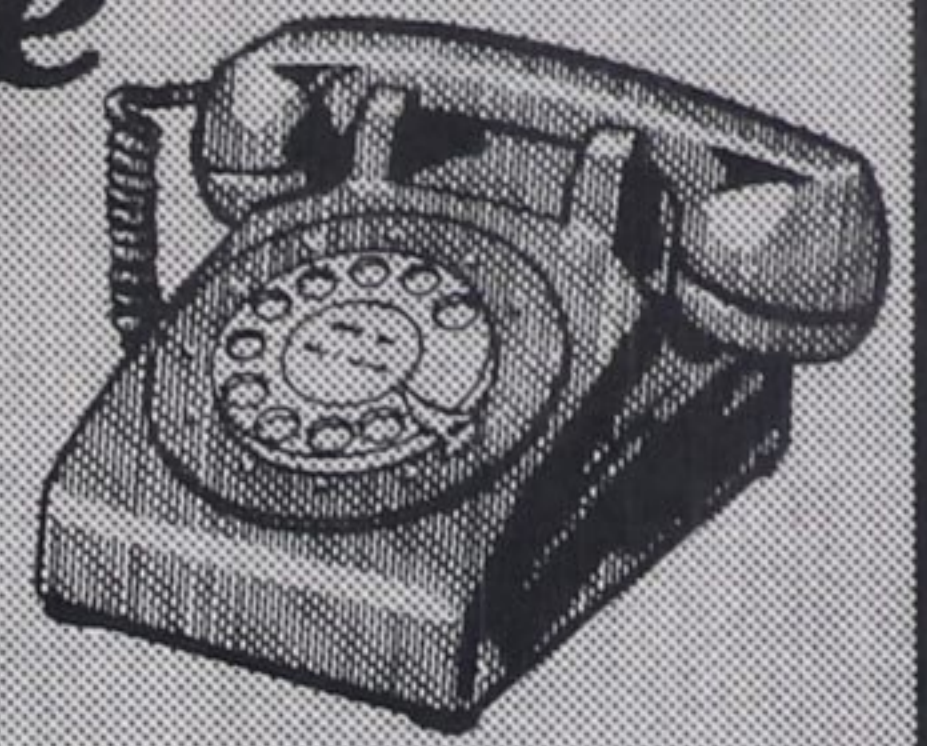
Search warrant executed
