TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Penetanguishene has passed By-law No. 1981-43 to designate the following property as being of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122:

NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

215 CHURCH STREET - By-law No. 1981-43.
St. James-on-the-Lines Church, constructed in 1836, stands as one of the oldest structures in the Town of Penetanguishene. It is recommended for designation as a fine, well-preserved example of frame with clapboard construction and for its strong historical importance to the Town and the Province. It was built through the efforts of the officers from the nearby Military Establishment, and maintained by its congregation in nearly its original state until today, and still serves as an active church. The attached cemetery has many head stones dating back to the 1830's. DATED at Penetanguishene this 27th day of May, 1981.
