In the third game that night, Midland edged out Christian Island, Sharon Borrow pitching for Midland.

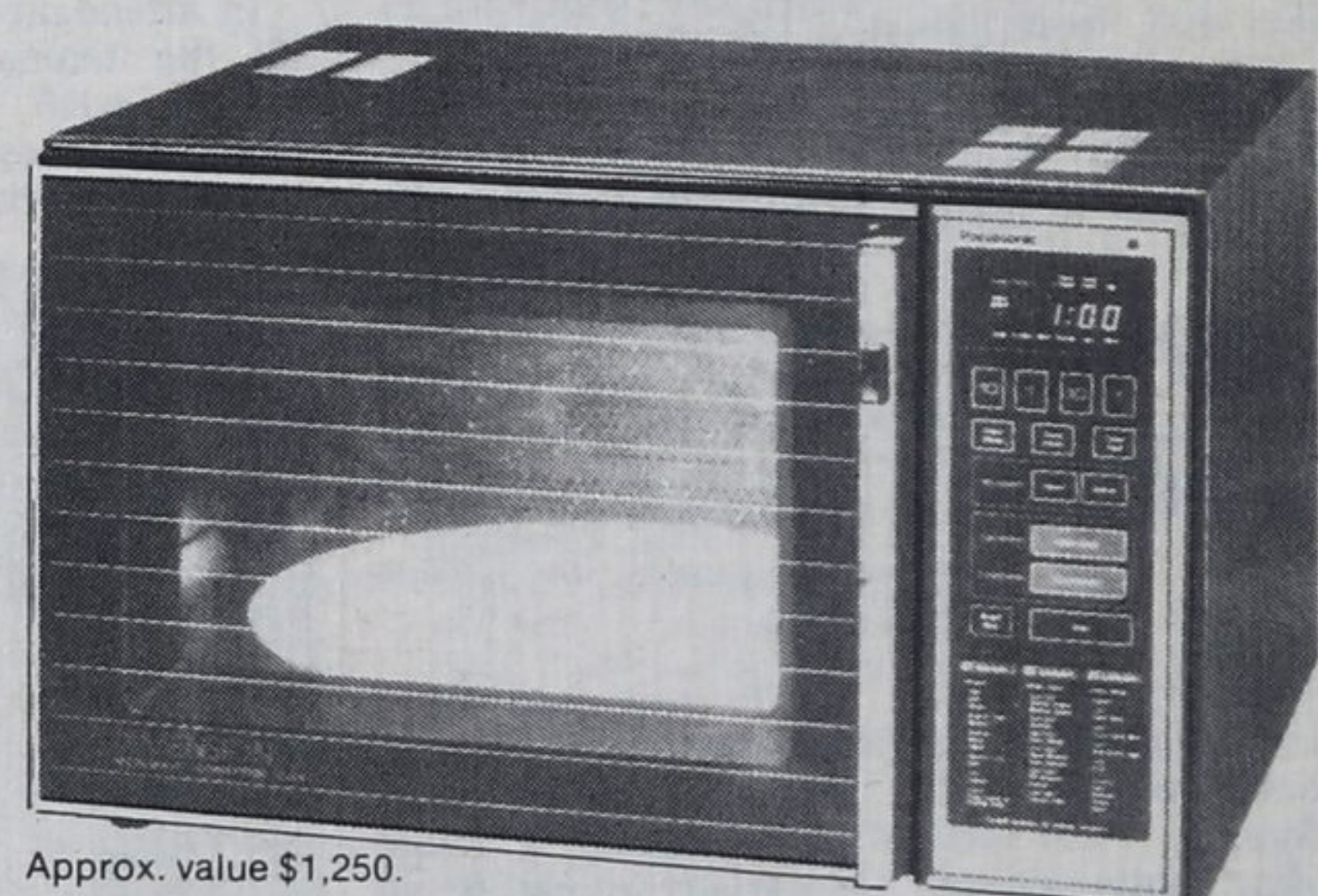
Midland again played Sunday at Christian Island, this time Midland winning by a score of 13-3 in five innings of play.
