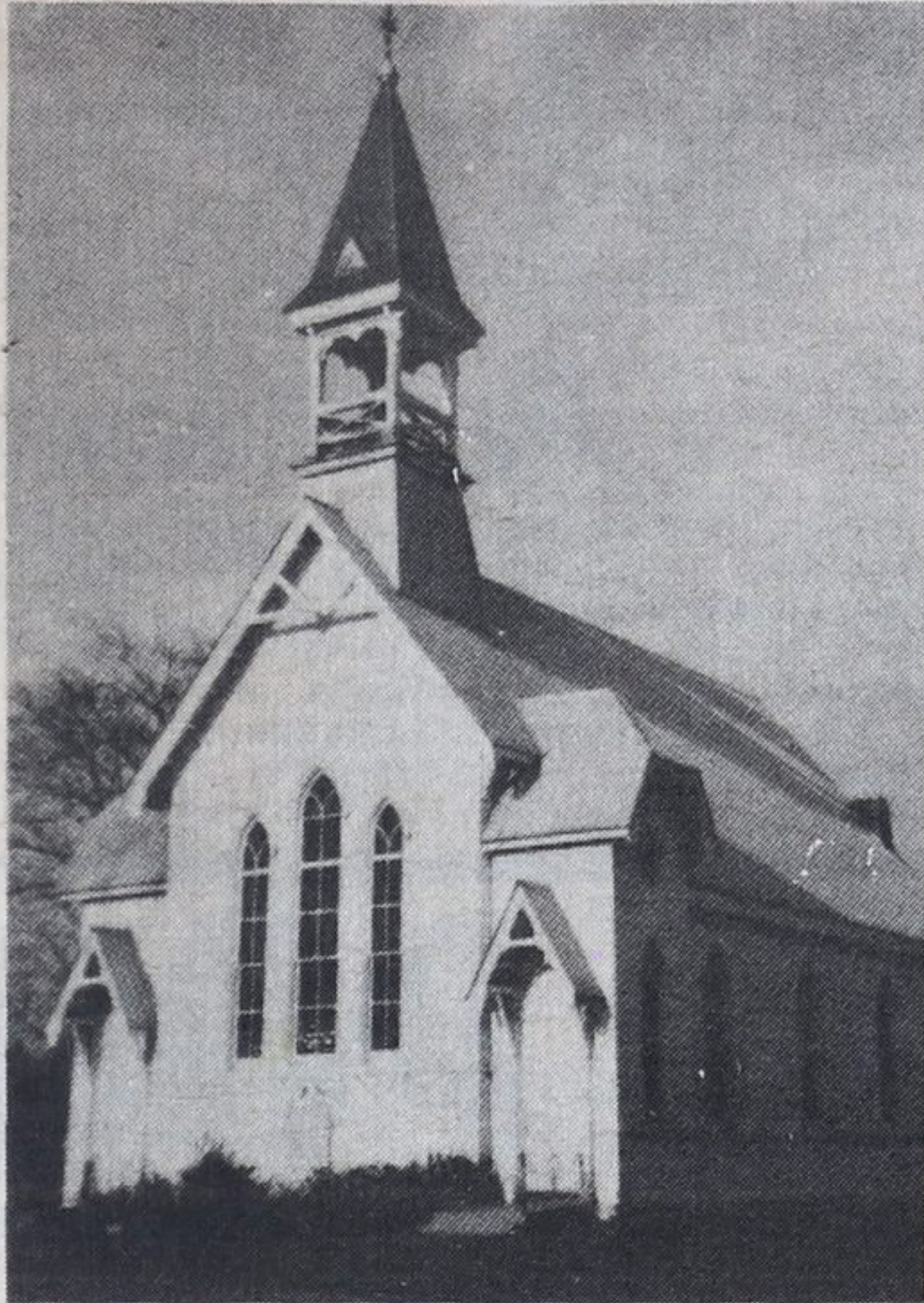

The United Church congregation of Waubausene Memorial Church is celebrating the 100th anniversary Aug. 9, 9 a.m.

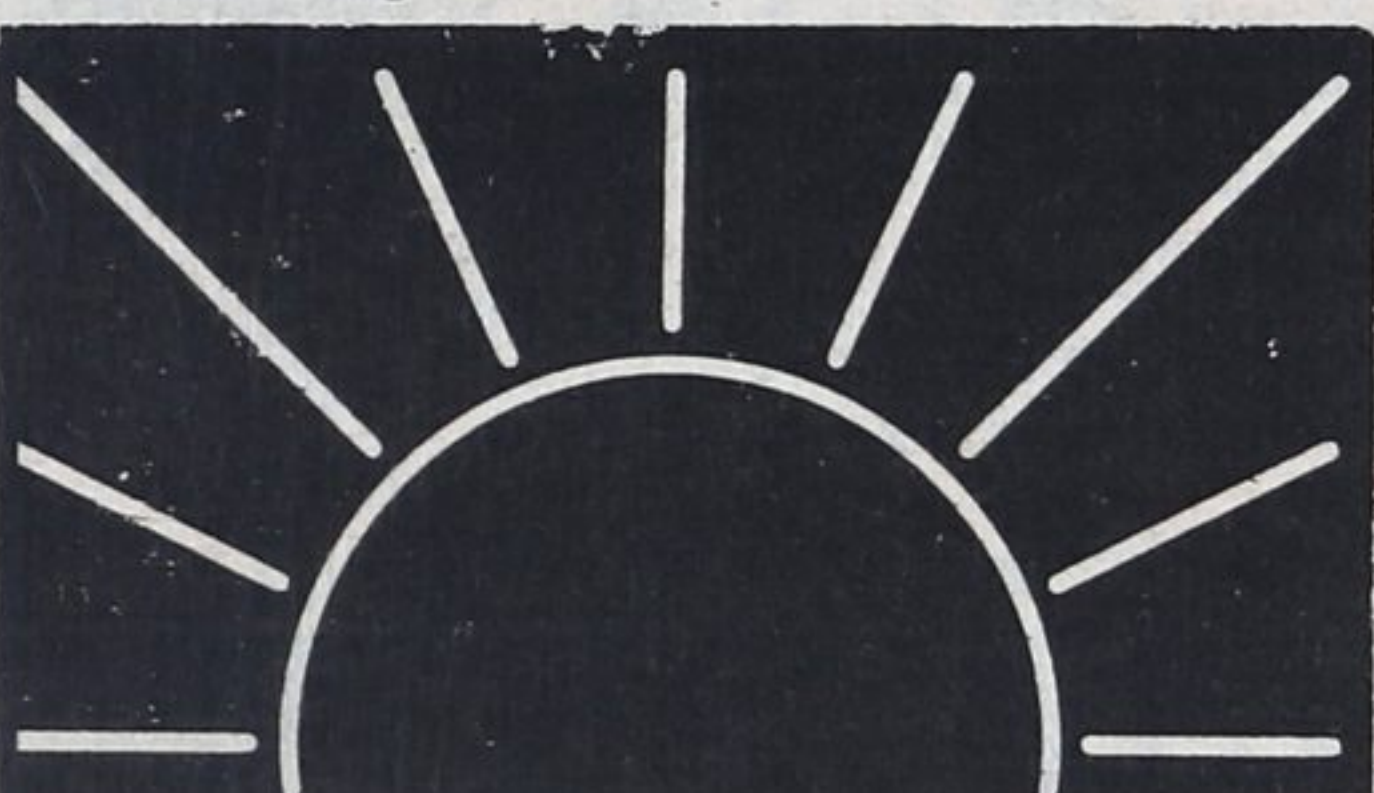
Rev. Ross Cummings of Stratford United Church will be the guest minister at this service.
