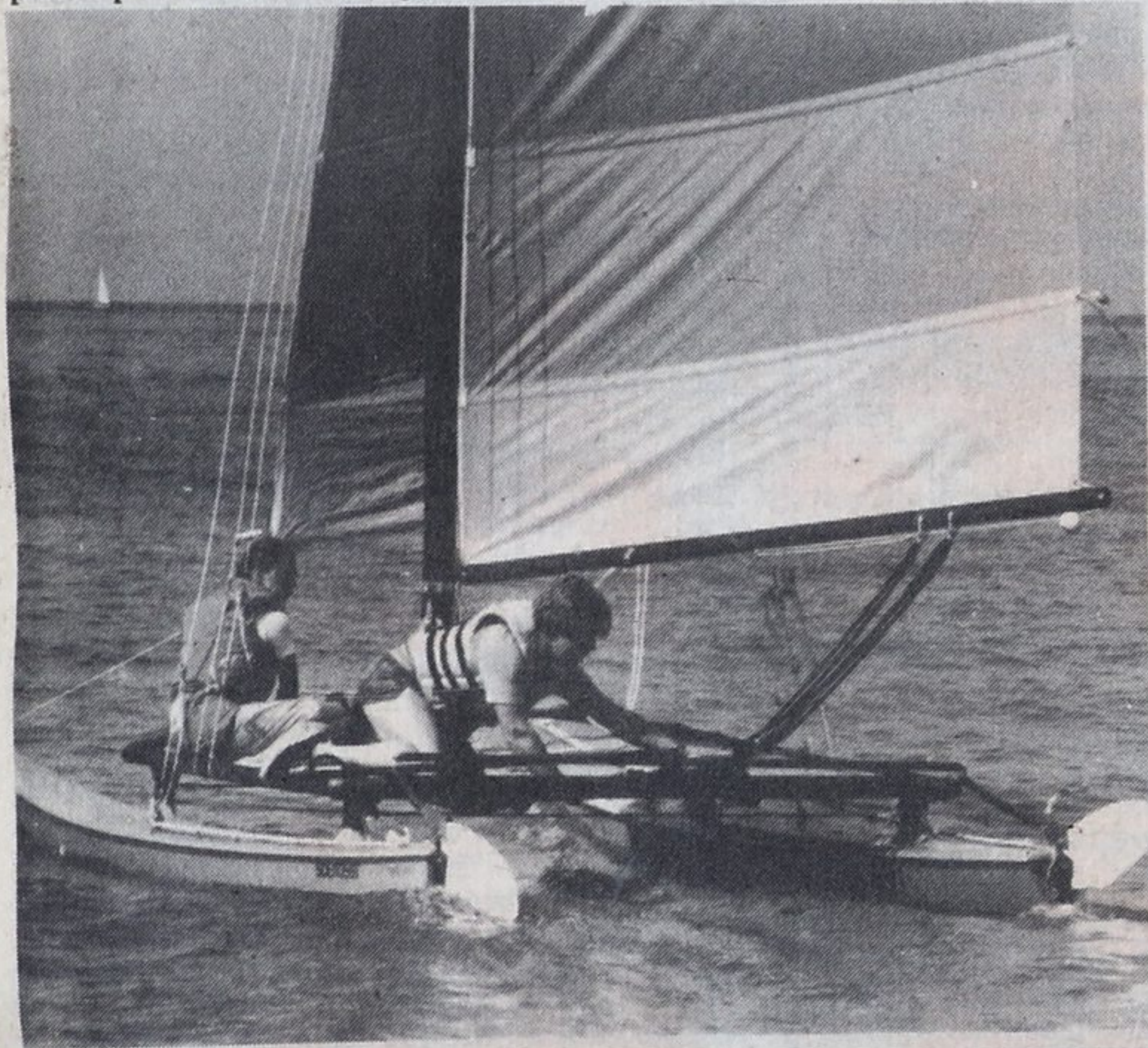




### Readying for race

Winning pitcher in last Wednesday night's game was Sue Brock

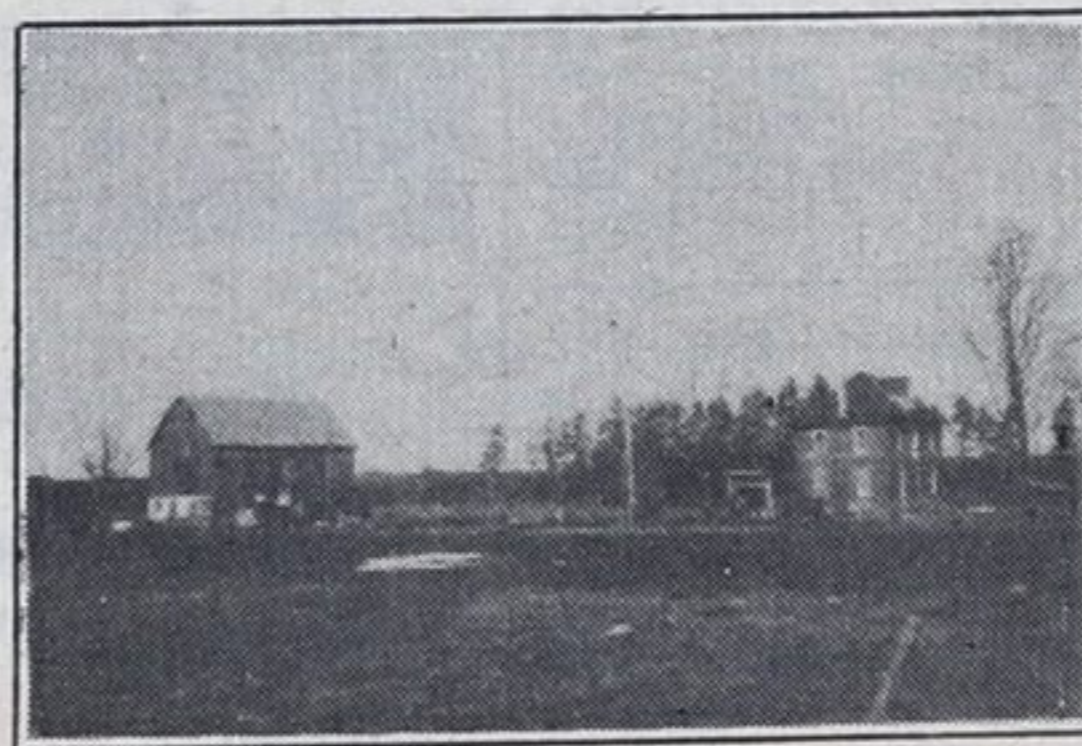

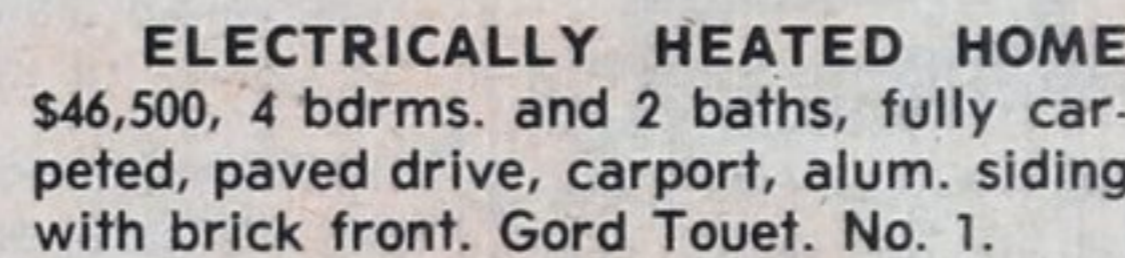
