Commissioner of Works Percy Ehler has been given permission by both the town's public works committee and Midland council to call tenders for public works equipment.

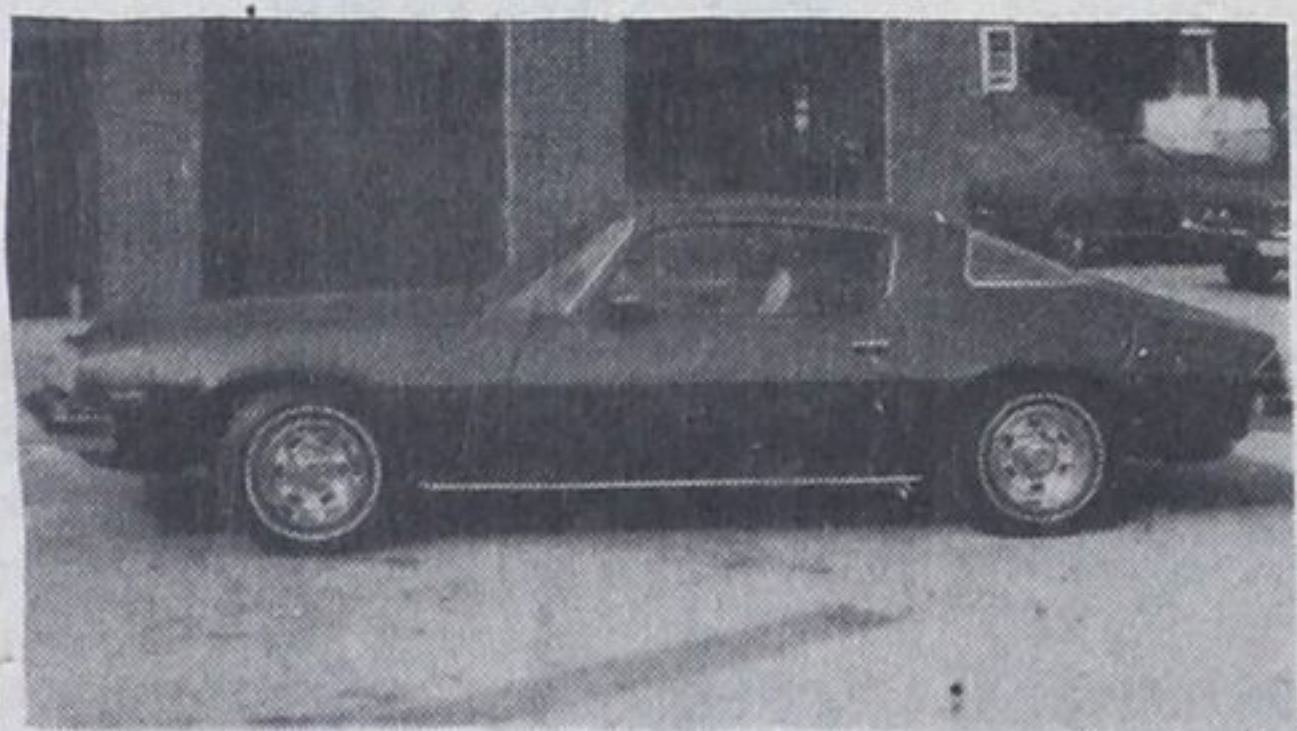
## Penetanguishene winter registrations tonight

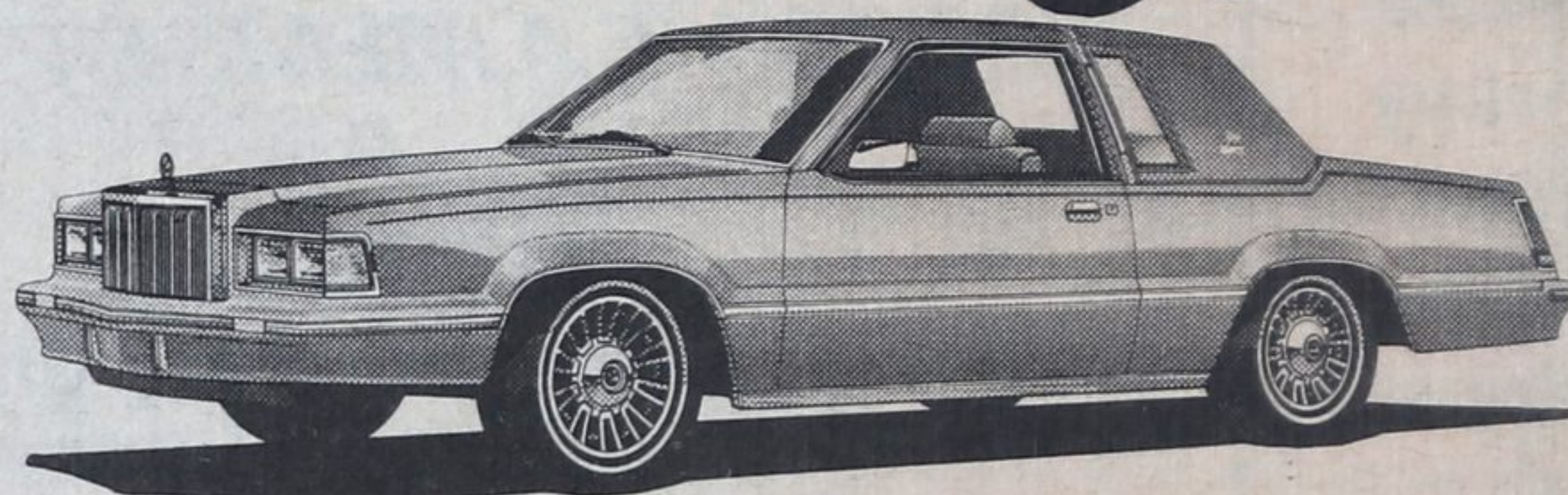

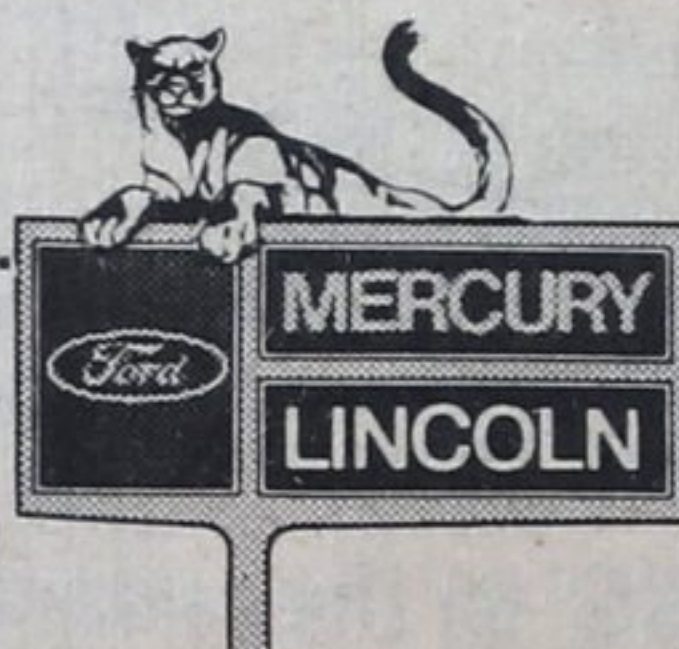
