dumped the Unknowns 12-2, and Midnite Express blanked Hydro 8-0.

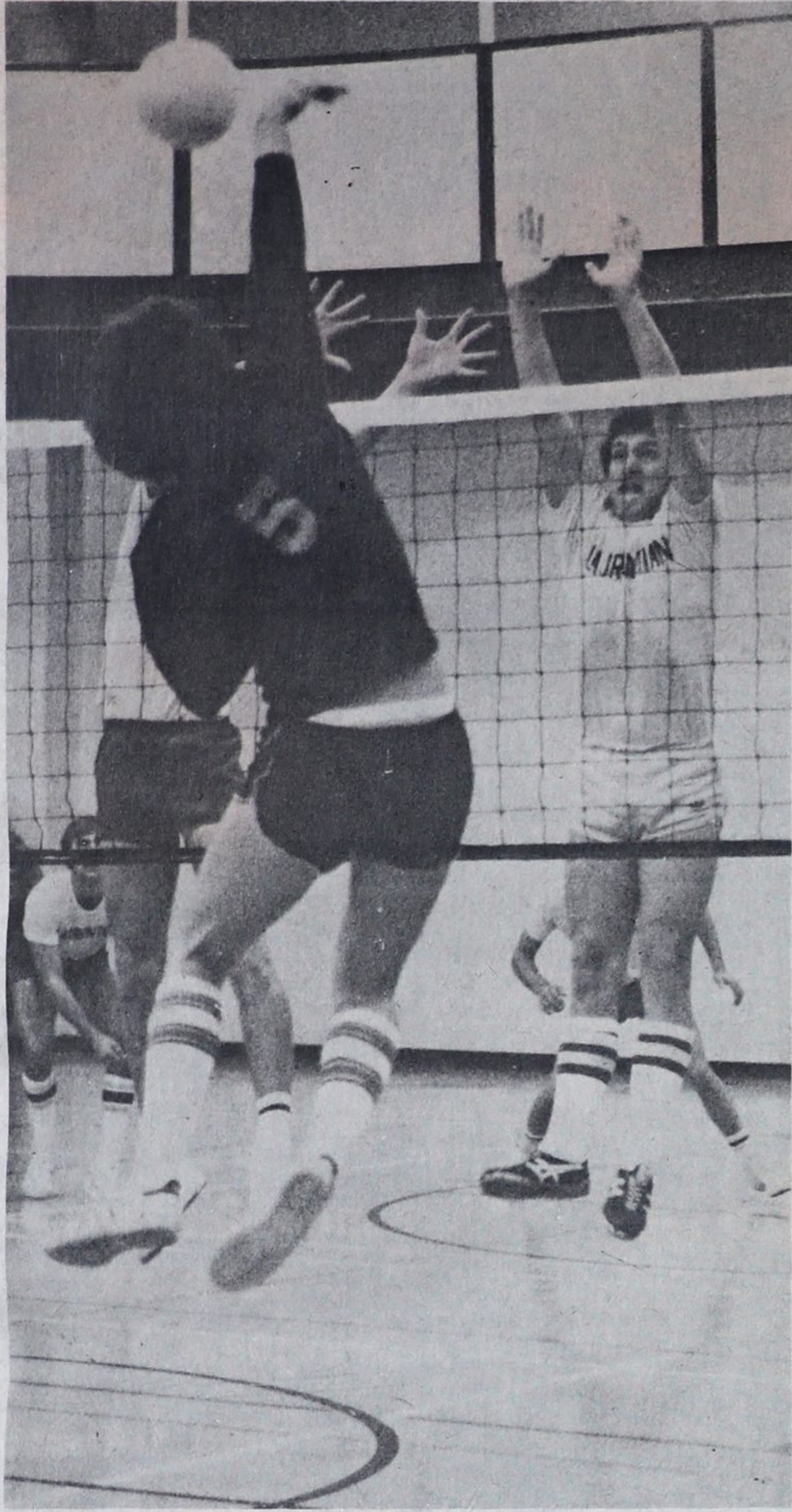

Today a big one for MSS

Today could be D-Day for the Midland Secondary School Marauders.

The "D" in this case is for Division playoffs, in which they'll have an almost certain berth if they can come up with a victory over unbeaten Collingwood Collegiate Institute this afternoon at MSS.

An MSS victory in today's 3 p.m. matchup would give each team a 5-1 record with only one game apiece remaining on the schedule. And after that, Midland would only have to get by Ecole Secondaire Penetanguishene Secondary School -- a feat which they accomplished with ease last time -- to earn a one of the two playoff spots in the six-team Simcoe County Senior North Division.

If they lose, however, Collingwood will almost surely ice a spot and there will be at least a couple of schools breathing down the Marauders' necks.

The Marauders should be ready for this kind of pressure after last Friday's harrowing 16-14 victory over host Stayner Collegiate Institute.

The win came on the last play of the game when quarterback Steve Friesen hit tight end Steve Frost with a short pass to complete a Midland rally which brought them back from a 14-2 deficit with only seven minutes remaining in the game.

Midland's first points came early when Mark Arbour nabbed the Stayner quarterback in his own end zone for the safety. Midland's other major came on a 10-yard run from halfback Gary Beausoliel.

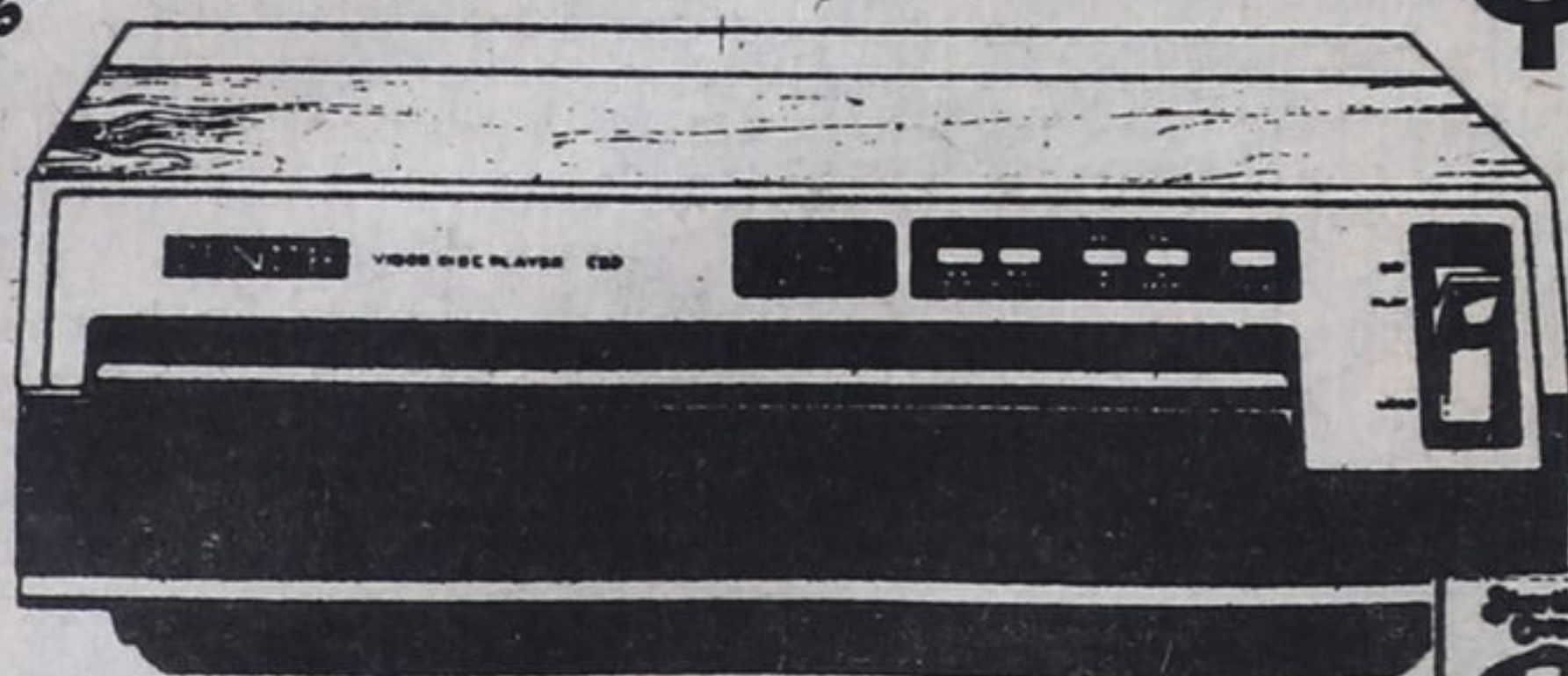
