DISPENSE WITH A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Penetanguishene intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the purchase of certain lands and premises, presently owned by Donald Sherk, of 24 Centennial Drive in the Town of Penetanguishene, County of Simcoe, and being all of Lots 31 and 32, Registered Plan 1521 at an estimated cost of One Hundred and Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$118,000.00) whereof the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) shall be raised by the sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding ten (10) years.

2. Application will be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works.
