Department for servicing and a cash contribution of \$10,500 from the town.

The servicing scheme enables the town to

service the lots which are involved in the acquisition of land from Don Sherk on Centennial Drive.

Commission recommending "high action as a priority" in view of the favourable purchase price of the property.


