One program called "Customized Comfort" for \$79.00 includes a high mountain category room, free local phone calls, fruit basket on arrival; early morning coffee with the Wall Street Journal and Honolulu Advertiser delivered to the room.

The "Sweet Suite" promotion is for those paying normal suite rates.

It includes fruit basket and flowers on arrival, evening turn-down service with orchid on the pillow; a gift each night; coffee and newspaper delivered to the room at the time specified by automatic wake-up call; and extra bathroom amenities, such as shampoo, shaving kits, shower caps and special soaps.

Disabled persons can travel with electric wheelchairs on all of Air Canada's routes rather than only those normally serviced by wide-bodied aircraft.

Safety regulations do not permit wheelchairs powered by liquid acid or "wet cell" batteries on DC9, 8 and 727's. A new leak-proof packing process now makes it possible to carry the "wet cell" batteries safely.

Batteries are removed from the wheelchair and ventilation caps replaced with non-spillable caps. The battery is wrapped in absorbent material secured with tape, placed in a plastic bag and stored in a heavy cardboard box. Advise your travel agent if you require this service when booking your flight.

Prince George Adds An Extra Day

Canadian Cruise Lines SS Prince George will operate an eight day schedule from Vancouver, up the Inside passage, to Alaska starting April 30.

The extra day will allow more time in ports of call. A new port has been added to the ship's itinerary. As well as Ketchikan, Juneau, Skagway and Prince Rupert, the town of Wrangell will be visited.

The cruise will visit Tracy Arm, considered one of the most scenic locations along the Canada Alaska coast. The Prince George is one of the few cruise vessels of a size that allows it to navigate Tracy Arm plus Wrangell Narrows.

New Sea World Exhibit Opens

California's intertidal zone - both land and sea and always changing has been recreated at Sea World. As casually as they would stroll the beach at low tide, guests may walk the 90 foot length of the exhibit, sit on a rock ledge and reach down to hold and examine one of the dozens of species of marine life that are at home here.

The park's new exhibit spotlights the bright orange Garibaldi, a feisty fish with the unofficial designation of California state
