

Selected news highlights

At the Jan. 12 meeting of Elmvale village council, the village building inspector, Roger Neal, alleged to council that Elmvale's reeve had instructed him to issue a building permit on a piece of construction already in progress. Neal was referring to an addition

at Elmvale Farm Supply. Neal refused to issue a building permit on the advice of his lawyer, he said. Heated debate between council members followed. Neal was asked to resign.

Council at its Jan. 26 meeting repealed the bylaw making Neal the

village's bylaw enforcement officer, before finding a replacement. Council went in camera to discuss whether Neal would stay as secretary of the village's committee of adjustment. Neal was not removed.

February
Pat Maloney, 22, a

part-time teller at Elmvale's Toronto-Dominion Bank, and her boyfriend, Wayne Booth, won \$100,000 in a Wintario draw. Chlorine was introduced to the village water system because of unacceptable levels of coliform bacteria. At a special meeting of council in early February, Hedley Lucock was appointed village building inspector. Mr. and Mrs. John Coe of Elmvale

celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary, as did Mr. and Mrs. Elbridge Spence.

March

Plans for an addition to Elmvale District High School were approved by the Simcoe County Board of Education, and a delegation was sent to the Ministry of Education. A delegation to a Simcoe County Roman Catholic School Board meeting

told the board Elmvale's Our Lady of Lourdes School was a fire hazard, a health hazard, and crowded. The source of the bacteria in the village water system turned out to be in the town's well. PC George Taylor was re-elected to Queen's Park.

April

Robert Sherriff replaced as of May 1 Hedley Lucock as Elmvale's building

inspector. Joyce Currie of Elmvale was selected Parent of the Year by the Barrie chapter of Parents Without Partners.

Flos Township Deputy-Reeve Donald Bell received the Royal Bank of Canada Silver Tray Award at a Huronia Dairy Herd Improvement Association banquet. Queen of the 15th annual Elmvale Maple Syrup Festival was Caroline Watson.
