August

rope, and found near Hillsdale. The body was later identified as that of Daniel McRae, 24, of Toronto. Van Ha, son of Mr. and Mrs. Chan Ha of Elmvale, was the Ontario Scholar at EDHS with the highest average, 94 per cent. Peter and Cindy Tingey won a 1981 car at the annual Elmvale and District Lions Club car draw.

September
Agreement on how many of the 100 lots in

the Elmvale Estates subdivision were to be released for sale was reached between the village council and the developer: 38. An amendment of the village official plan allowed the building of a nursing home on North William Street. George Street, Elmvale, resident Roy Archer won \$25,000 in a Wintario draw. Medonte township council conceded to an annexation bid from its neighbour, Coldwater. The

October

Elmvale District High School was placed at the top of the list of capital cost projects submitted by the Simcoe County Board of Education to the Ministry of Education, for approval, each year.

Medonte Township council voted down reassessment of the township. Elmvale council sought a 13 per cent increase in village hydro rates from Ontario Hydro.
