New Apex Fare to Portugal

CP Air and TAP Air Portugal will introduce a \$599 Super Apex return fare to Lisbon from Toronto and Montreal, Jan. 31.

Morocco Tours

Kuoni Travel is offering three itineraries to Morocco. Non stop Royal Air Maroc flights depart weekly on Saturdays from Mirabel Airport to Agadir and Casablanca.

Kuoni's Imperial Cities tour reflects a land of contrasts, featuring one week of travel by motorcoach to the cities of Rabat, Meknes, Fez and Marrakech, and a second week spent in Agadir on the Atlantic Ocean.
