

Budget's a biggy!

Simcoe County's new 1982 budget was etched in marble yesterday during a regular sitting of county council at Midhurst.

Although county councillors had been presented with 'ball park figures' at an earlier council meeting, yesterday's session was for all the marbles.

The new budget was struck at \$5,174,000 after being fine-tuned earlier in the month using a new formula set out by the province for setting and collecting taxes owed the county from municipal corporations in Simcoe County.

When the smoke had cleared, three

very key bylaws were approved; one to provide for the raising of the sum of \$2,214,000 for expenditures on county and suburban roads and connecting links, another for \$2,960,000 for the general expenditures in the county for the coming year.

Once those two important bylaws cleared the decks, county councillors proceeded to approve a third one which determines the percentage share each municipality within the county shall contribute for county purposes.

Of interest locally are what Midland and area municipalities will have to fork over to the county:
