TOWNSHIP OF TAY NOTICE

RESTRICTION OF OPEN FIRES

APRIL 1ST st to OCTOBER 31st
 BY-LAW NO. 1409 STATES THE FOLLOWING:

- No person shall set a fire on a public road or highway.
- No person shall set a fire in the open air to burn grass, leaves or other debris except in an incinerator, without first obtaining permission from the local fire-chief or his deputy. Incinerator in this By-law shall mean a receptacle or place to light a fire that is approved by the fire chief and your local fire chief is the chief of the Fire Department serving your area.
- No person shall set a fire in the open air to burn grass, brush or other debris without first taking all precautions to prevent the fire from getting out of control.
- No person shall set a fire in the open air to dispose of grass, brush or other debris, except during the times authorized by the local fire-chief or his deputy.
- No person shall set a fire in the open air to dispose of grass, brush or other debris without first having:
 - a sufficient number of adult persons available to control the fire
 - sufficient water or other equipment available to keep the fire under control.
- No fires shall be set in the open air if there is a dangerous wind or periods of high winds.
- No person shall set a fire or permit a fire to burn within twenty(20) feet of a wooden building or fifteen (15) feet of any other building.
- All fires must be guarded until dead out.
- Any person who sets a fire in the open air without the permission of the fire-chief or otherwise, requiring the attendance of the fire-chief shall be responsible for the costs of the Fire Department.
- Any Person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$50.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs. Fire Permits for Sunnyside, Portage Park and Tay Point may be obtained from the Midland Fire Department.
