## RESTRICTION OF OPEN FIRES

## APRIL 1ST st to OCTOBER 31st

BY-LAW NO. 1409 STATES THE FOLLOWING: 1. No person shall set a fire on a public road or highway.

2. No person shall set a fire in the open air to burn grass, leaves or other debris except in an incinerator, without first obtaining permission from the local fire-chief or his deputy.

Incinerator in this By-law shall mean a receptacle or place to light a fire that is approved by the fire chief and your local fire chief is the chief of the Fire Department serving your are.

3. No person shall set a fire in the pen air to burn grass, brush or other debris without first taking all precautions to prevent the fire from getting of of

4. No person shall set the in the open air to dispose of grass, brush or other debris, except during the times authorized by the local fire-chief or his deputy.

5. No person shall set a fire it the open air to dispose of grass, blush or other debris without first having:

(a) a sufficient number of adult persons available to control the fire (b) sufficient water or other equipment available to keep the fire under control.

6. No fires shall be set in the open air if there is a dangerous wind or periods of high winds. 7. No person shall set a fire or permit a fire to

burn within twenty(20) feet of a wooden building or fifteen (15) feet of any other building. 8. All fires must be guarded until dead out.

9. Any person who sets a fire in the open air without the permission of the fire-chief or otherwise, requiring the attendance of the firechief shall be responsible for the costs of the Fire Department.

10. Any Person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$50.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs.

Fire Permits for Sunnyside, Portage Park and Tay Point may be obtained from the Midland Fire Department.
