

Anchor store for mall project clears hurdle

K Mart coming to area

That regional mall planned for Highway 93 west of Midland - Mountainview Shopping Centre - to be developed by Burnac Leaseholds Ltd., Toronto has received a new lease on life as well as a healthy shot in the arm.

Last week the Township of Tiny extended the company's building permit for an additional six months which will allow the firm to commence construction in late summer.

Initially plans last year called for the 323,000 square foot \$7.7 million structure to be opened this year. However rising costs for materials over the last year forced re-pricing of the project.

Meanwhile Trevor Smith, president of Burnac Leaseholds Ltd., last Wednesday in a

press release made the following announcement:

"The board of directors of Burnac is pleased to announce that K Mart Department Store will be located in the Mountainview Mall project.

"K Mart, who are in their 20th year of business in Canada, have 117 stores in operation.

"Situated on 26 acres of land, the mall project will now consist of a Zellers Department Store of 82,000 square feet, a Dominion Store Supermarket occupying 35,000 square feet, a K Mart Department Store of 58,000 square feet, and approximately 60 other stores in the expansion, bringing the total retail space to some 323,000 square feet."

privilege, Vince Evenden, we appreciated the chance to join in one of the most beautiful evenings of music.

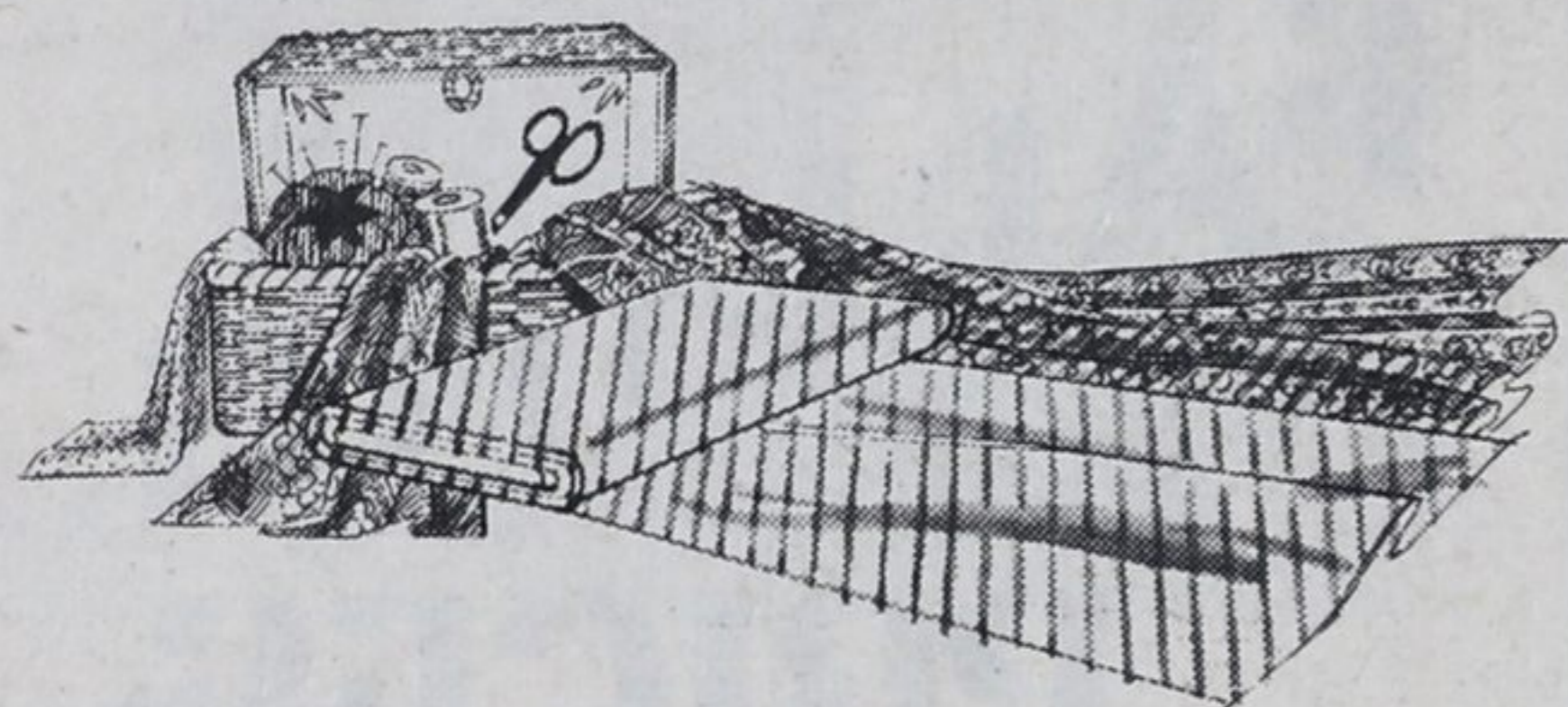
Now it's back to the rehearsal for the Show. The songs are great, the setting is good, and we have a headliner quartet second to none.
