Susan Lamers and Wayne Cadeux were runners-up in the mixed doubles event of last week's competition and Kelly Swales and Patti Cox finished second in the girls' doubles event.

The top two in each event at the GB event at the GB earned the right to compete in Monday's provincial championships at Queen's University in Kingston.

Lamers and Cadeux were defeated 15-6, 15-8 by Jane and Andrew Mathieson of Markham Secondary School in last Thursday's final at ESPSS.

Swales and Cox were dumped 15-10, 15-1 by Janet McRuer and Colleen McKeown of Banting Memorial Secondary School of Alliston in the girls' doubles final at MSS.

Barrie's Eastview Secondary School won the overall school title, Base Borden Secondary School captured the mens' divisional title and Banting came up with the girls' GBSSA school trophy in the girls' section.

More than 80 players from five GBSSA zones took part in the one-day competition.

Joe Hartford of Base Borden earned the mens' singles title with a 15-2, 16-8 decision over Al Sutherland of King City Secondary School.
