Both her husband, Charles Labbe, and her father, Joseph Pigeau, predeceased her.

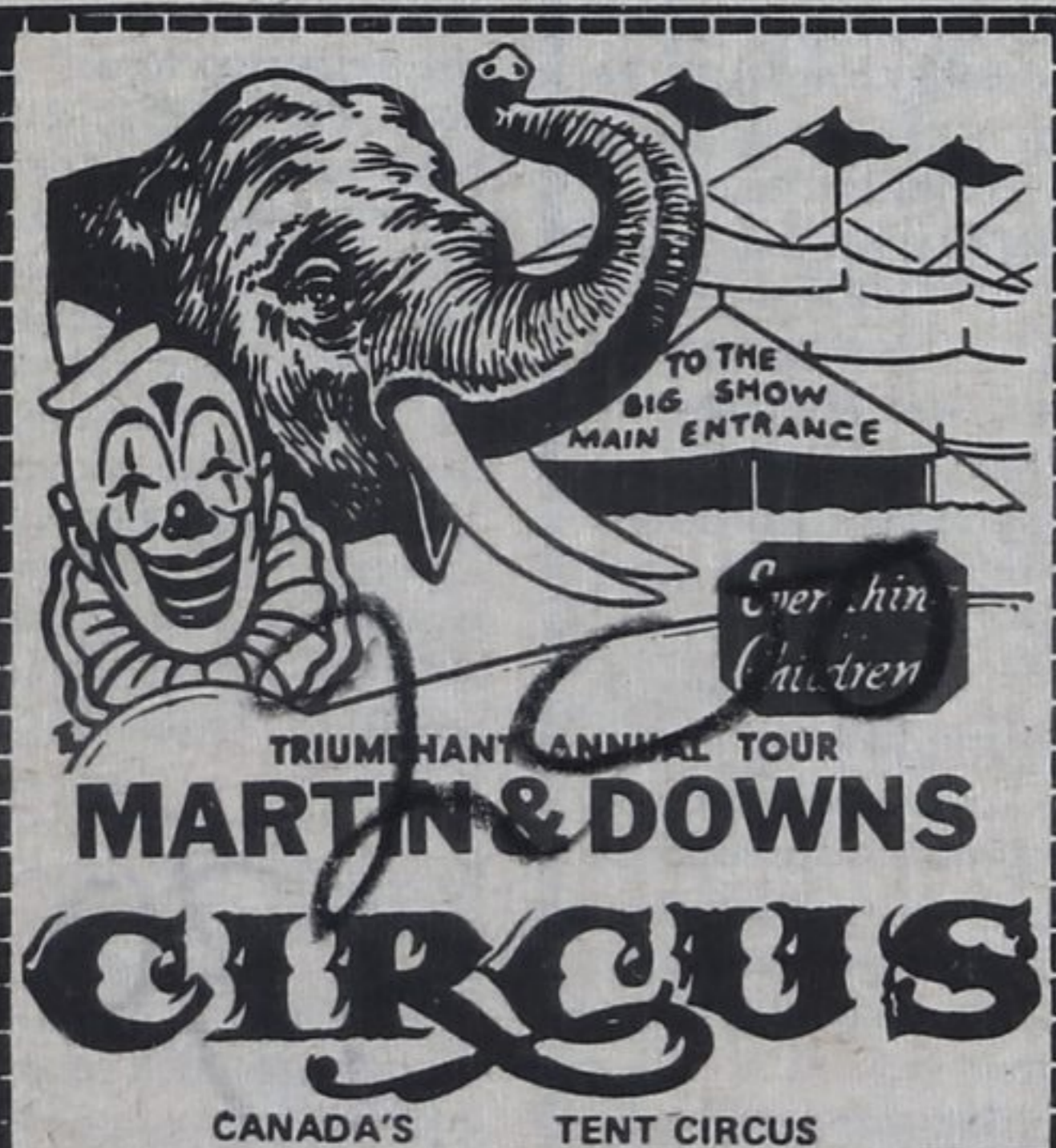
She was born in Bonfield Township, Nipissing District.

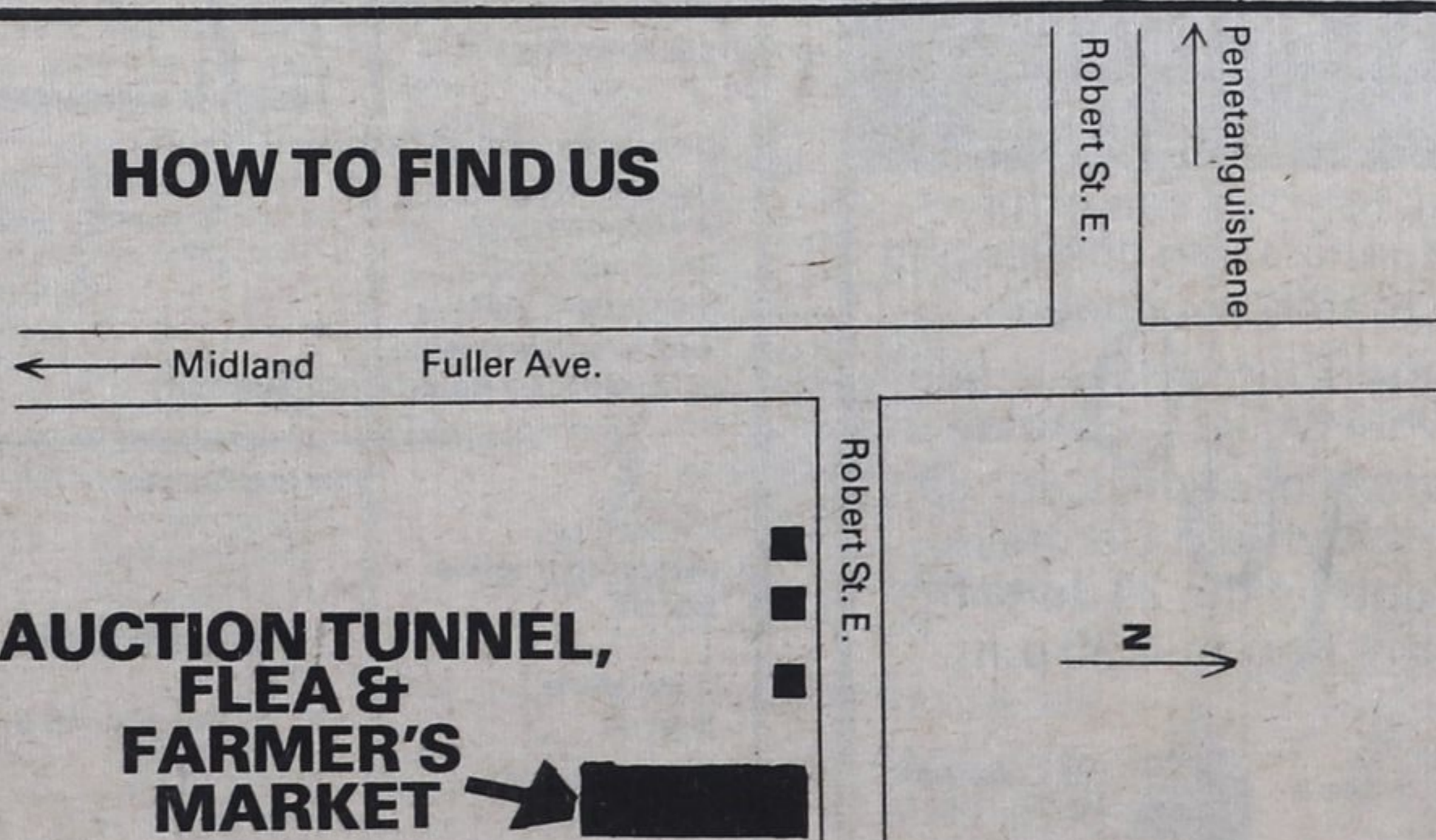
