JUNE 26-27 LIBERTY DAYS Historic Naval and Military Establishments, (End of Church St., Penetanguishene). Free to those dressed in Centennial Costume and to those wearing official Centennial Pin. Regular admissionrates for others. Join the activities: Enjoy music, drama, historical presentations and naval demonstrations. This is also a unique opportunity for out-of-town visitors to check the descendant's day registry.
