## TOWN OF PENETANGUIHENE Need Repairs to your home?

**MONEY IS STILL AVAILABLE FOR HOME AND RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNIT REPAIRS**

Applications are being accepted again for home owners and landlords wishing to apply for financial assistance for home and rental residential unit repairs under the R.R.A.P. (Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program) which is a Federal sponsored program, and O.H.R.P. (Ontario Home renewal Program) which is a Provincial sponsored program. Home owners and landlords in Penetanguishene, with the exception of those units in the town's new subdivision, Rolling Sands Estates, and Brule Heights Subdivision are eligible to receive R.R.A.P. or O.H.R.P. funds for residential unit repairs. Home owner loans are geared to income. The interest rate, which ranges from 0 per cent to 16 per cent, depending on which program is used, is geared to income. The programs provide loans with forgiveness portions as follows:

**O.H.R.P. HOUSING:**

Adjusted Family Income \$6,000.00 or less  
Maximum grant \$4,000.00 Total Max. loan \$7,500.00  
**Note:** \$15,500.00 A.F.I. is the maximum income where a grant or loan is available. The interest ranges from 0 per cent to 8 per cent depending on adj. fam. income.

**R.R.A.P. HOUSING:**

Adjusted Family Income \$9,000.00 or less  
Maximum loan \$3,750.00 Total max. loan \$10,000.00  
**Note:** \$16,450.00 A.F.I. is the maximum income where a grant for loan is available. Income above that is eligible for loan only. Present interest rate is 16 per cent over 1 to 20 years.

**R.R.A.P. RENTAL:**

**Note:** Not geared to income but to construction cost of repairs.

Maximum grant - 50 per cent of construction cost, to a maximum of \$2,500.00 per unit providing landlord matches equal amount of funds.
