Monday, back in Midland, Chris Walser scored two goals to pace the Braves to a 6-0 hammering of Huntsville.

The victory, combined with an 8-2 win over Barrie last Wednesday at Midland arena (Jason Perrault and Wadge, two each), helped further secure the club's league lead.

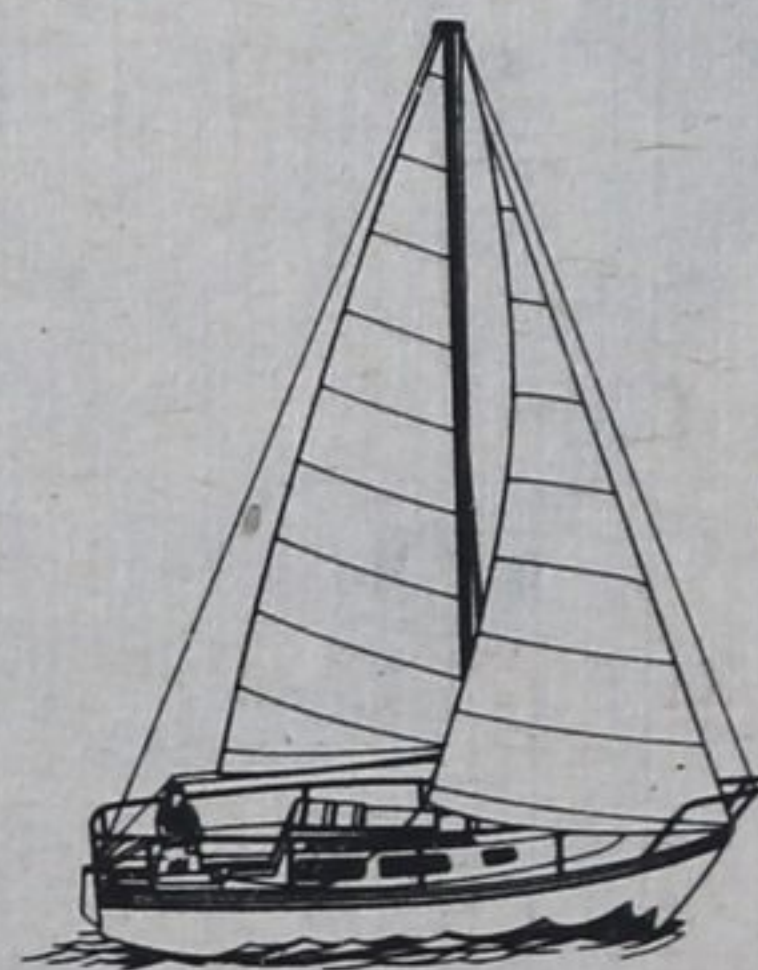
