The competition is open to any duos pair, one of whom must be 18 or under, and a full slate of 70 golfers are expected to post the \$18 (each) entry fee by the

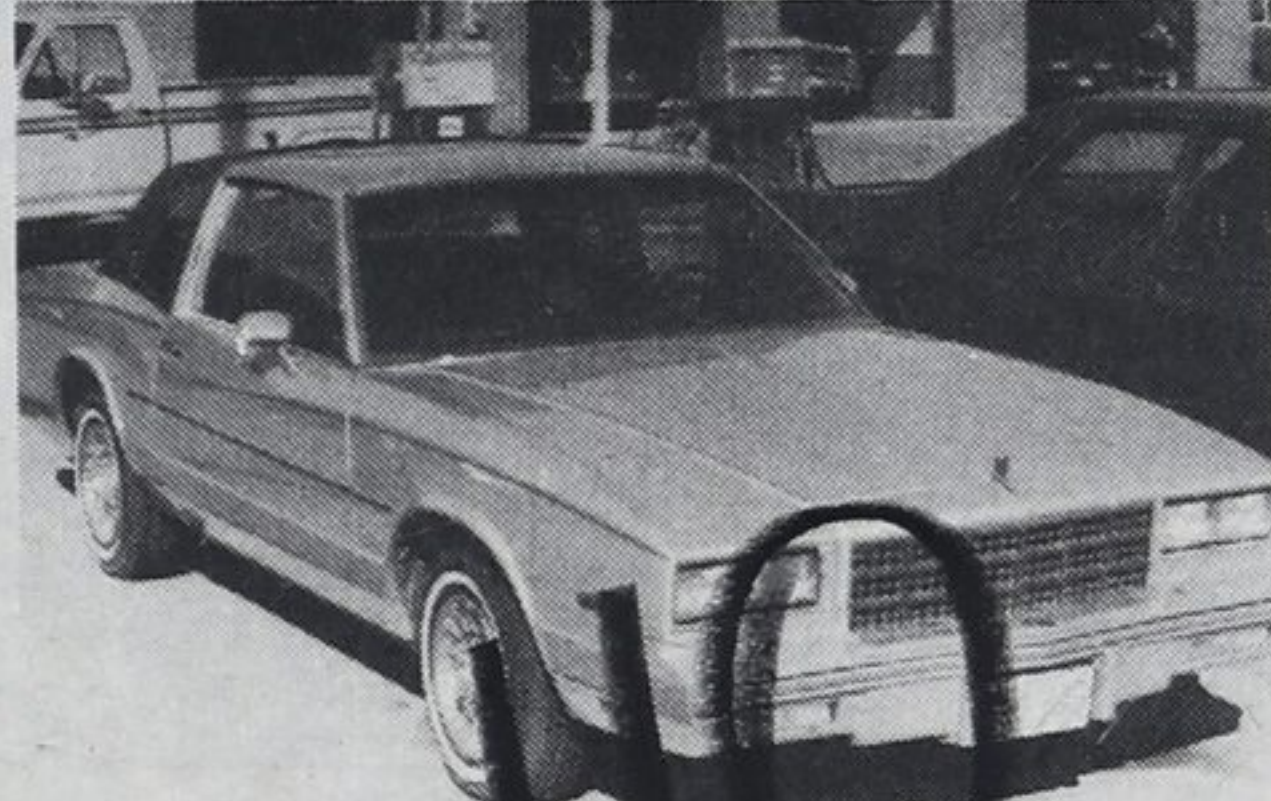
end of the week.

The fee includes a free practice round, a chipping contest for the Juniors and prizes and door prizes after the 18-hole main event.

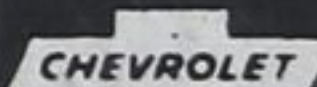
One other enticement is the offer of a set of TNT clubs for anyone aching the eighth hole.

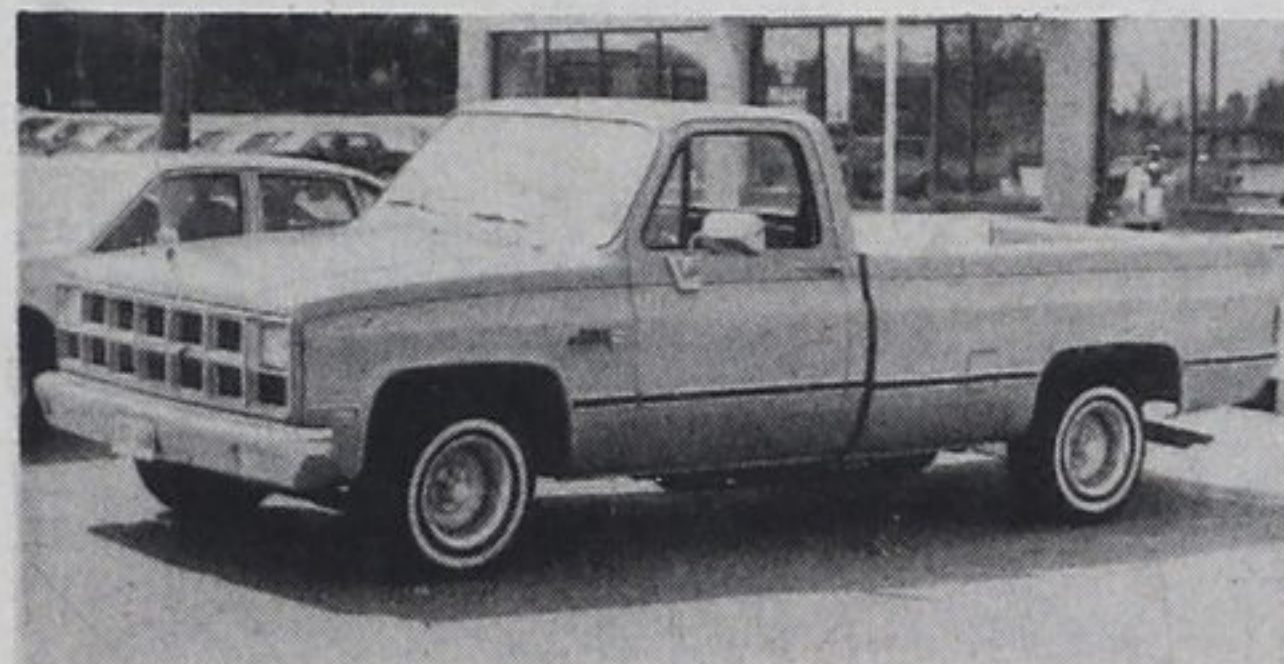

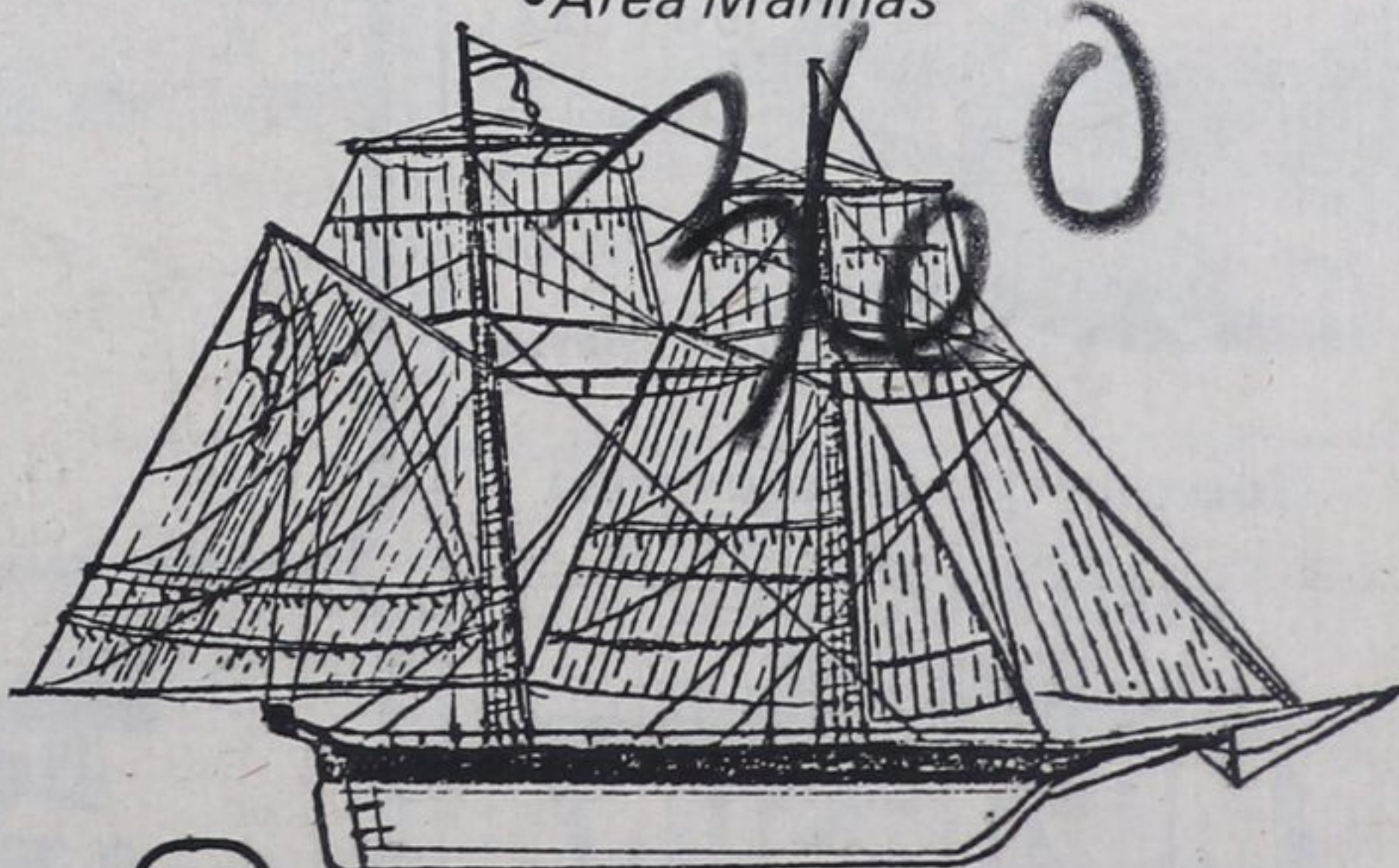
