

Contest Rules and Procedures

1. Nominations for "Boating Family of the Year" must be submitted by members of the media to ABC by September 1st, 1982.
2. Winning boating families in areas where nominations are made will be selected by an ABC committee of judges and announced prior to September 15th, 1982.
3. Selection of Canada's "Boating Family of the Year" will be made from those families who are chosen as Area Winners, by an ABC committee of judges, and will be announced prior to December 1st, 1982.

4. Area Winners will receive a cash award of \$500 to be presented to them at a special reception in their honour in September 1982.
5. The members of the media who nominate the Area Winners will receive a cash award of \$250.
6. The family selected as Canada's "Boating Family of the Year" will be brought to Toronto as guests of ABC and Canadian National Sportsmen's Shows during the Toronto International Boat Show in January 1983 for presentation of their cash award of \$1,000.
7. The member of the media who nominates the national "Boating Family of the Year" will receive a cash award of \$500.

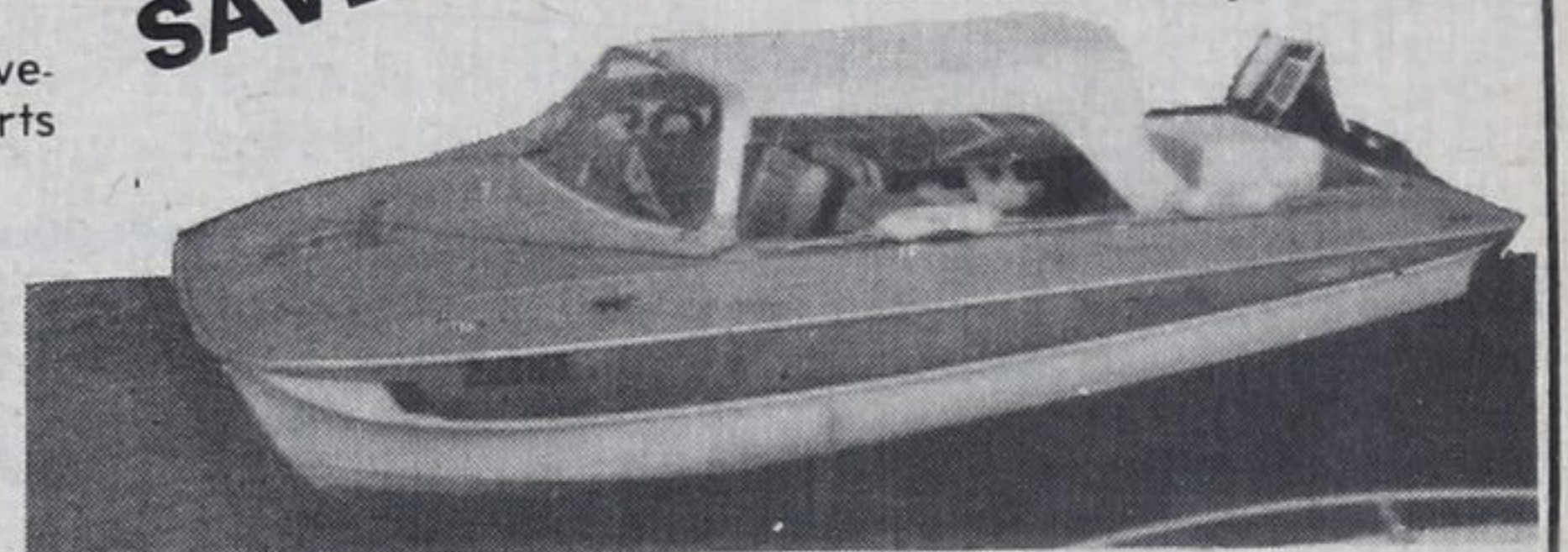

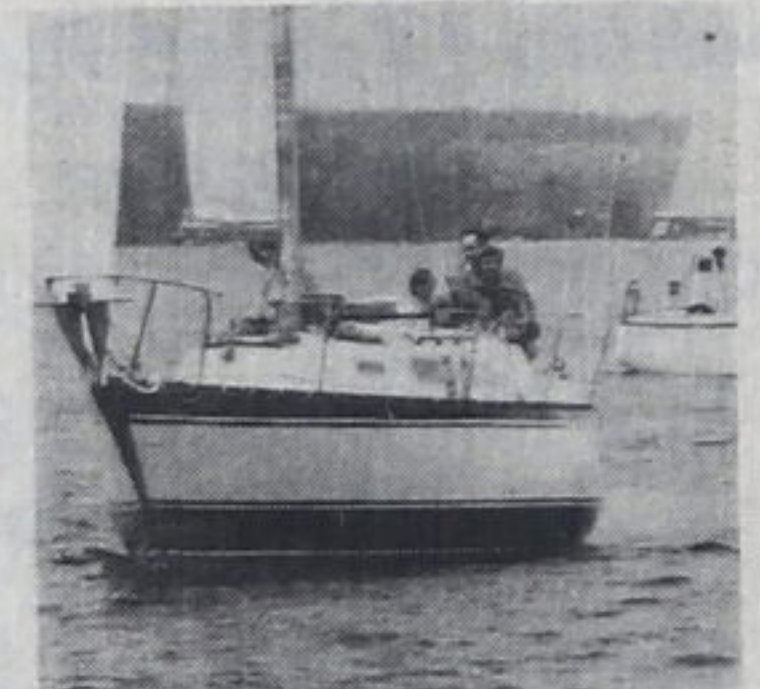

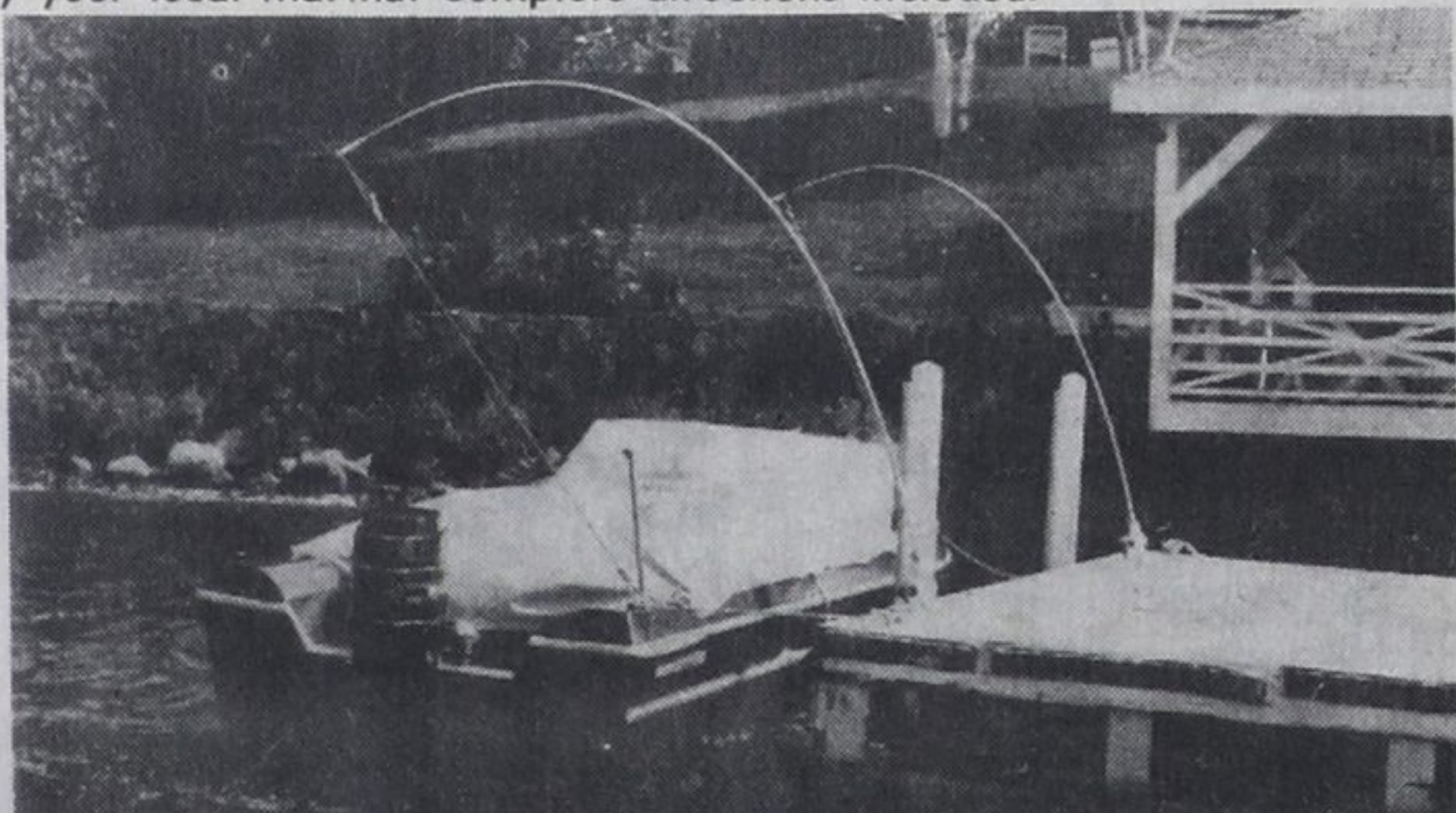
