That was the word this week from Simcoe East MPP Al McLean who along with officials from the C. of C., Simcoe North MP Doug Lewis and Mayor Moreland Lynn met at the chamber office on Wednesday to discuss the plight of RCA which plans to shut its doors for good, Dec. 31.

Efforts are also being made to obtain an ILAP (Industrial and Labour Adjustment Program) grant from the federal government so as to attract a new tenant for the Highway 12 factory.

Meanwhile McLean and union leaders from both RCA and the IUE will be meeting in Metro today with government officials in an effort to drum up provincial funds for a study which plans to look into the pros and cons of continuing to manufacture colour picture tubes in Midland.
