**Accident victim
was from Montreal**

Midland police said Wednesday, an autopsy at Huronia District Hospital, Wednesday morning, revealed 49-year-old Benito Fabrizio died of massive internal injuries. The mechanical assistant from Montreal fell 45 feet down a grain boat's smoke stack Tuesday afternoon. Police say the man wasn't wearing a safety harness at the time. He and another man had been assigned to scrape the inside of the stack on the Great Lakes grain carrier M. V. Mantadoc when the mishap occurred. The ship was tied up at the Tiffin Elevators. Fabrizio was rushed by ambulance to HDH where he died. Coroner Dr. H. C. Jilesen was called to the scene.

The next Red Cross Blood Donors' Clinic in Midland is set for Wednesday, Sept. 15, from 1:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

It's to be held at the Yonge Street West Civic Centre where donors will find plenty of free off-street parking.

The event will again be hosted by members of the Huronia Branch of the Red Cross. This month's target is 350 pints of blood.

Donors must be 18 to 66-years-old to give "the gift of life," however male and female donors between their 17th and 18th birthdays will be accepted at the clinic, under Red Cross policies with the written consent of their parents or guardians.

Donors must be of minimum weight and height: 100 pounds and 60 inches. They must also be in good general health.

If you plan to give "the gift of life" on Sept. 15 it is important to note the following reasons you might be excluded.

Permanent Exclusion
Hepatitis, Heart Disease, Elevated Blood Pressure, Stroke and other Circulatory Disorders, Cancer, Kidney Disease, Diabetes (on medication), Epilepsy, Thyroid Disease (Hyper or Hypo), Blood Disorders, Permanent Medication (except birth control pills, non-prescription vitamins and menopausal hor-

none replacement).

Short Term Deferrals
Minor acute illness, 3 weeks

Medication (after last dose), 72 hours minimum

Aspirin containing medication discuss with clinic nurse

Flu and colds, 1 week minimum

Active allergies, 72 hours minimum

Allergy injections, 1 week

Influenza vaccination, 48 hours

Polio vaccination, 1-3 weeks

Tetanus, typhoid, small pox or yellow fever vaccination, 3 weeks

Rubella vaccination, 3 months

Travel to malaria areas, 6 months.

Long Term Deferrals
Major acute illness, 6 months minimum

Major surgery, 6 months minimum

Minor surgery, 3 months minimum

Hepatitis contact, 6 months

Infectious mononucleosis (after full recovery), 6 months

Pregnancy (after delivery or abortion), 6 months

Breast feeding (after termination), 3 months

Blood transfusion, 6 months

Ear piercing, tattooing, acupuncture, 6 months.

Essential medications should not be discontinued for the purpose of donating blood.
