Notice of a Proposed By-law to name and re-name some streets, some parts of streets within the corporate limits of the Village of Victoria Harbour.

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Corporation of the Village of Victoria Harbour will take into consideration the passing and if approved will pass at a meeting to be held on the 12th day of October, 1982 at the hour of 7:30 o'clock in the evening at Council Chambers in the Village of Victoria Harbour, a by-law to provide for the following naming and changing of names of streets as follows:

1. For the purposes of the proposed by-law Midland, John, William, Richard, Jephson and Elizabeth streets all as shown on Registered Plan 201 shall be deemed to run East and West and Francis, Mary, Albert, Ellen, King, Queen and Victoria Streets on the said Plan shall be deemed to run North and South and the direction of all other streets in the Village of Victoria Harbour running parallel to the above streets shall have the same deemed direction.

2. All that portion of John Street as shown on Registered Plan 1404 is hereby re-named to Adeline Avenue.

3. That the Street lying between Lots 26 and 27 as shown on Registered Plan 1107 shall hereby be named and known as Coal Dock Road.

4. The whole of Jeuno Street as shown on Registered Plan 1107 shall be re-named to Juneau Road.

5. All that portion of Eplett Avenue lying in the Village of Victoria Harbour as shown on Registered Plan 861 shall hereinafter be re-named and known as Robins Point Road.

6. The street lying between Lots 16 and 17 on Registered Plan 795 shall be named and known as Queen Victoria's Common.

7. All that portion of Lot 14, Concession 7 formerly in the Township of Tay now in the Village of Victoria Harbour and described in Registered Instrument Number 246 and as shown on Plan 51R-9964 and described and known as Brown Street shall be re-named and known as Newton Street.

8. All that portion of Mary Street as shown on Registered Plan 201 lying North of the northern limit of Jephson Street and South of the northerly limit of Richard Street shall be re-named and known as St. Mary's Crescent.

9. All that part of Richard Street according to Registered Plan 201 lying West of the easterly limit of Mary Street and East to the westerly limit of Francis Street all as shown and according to Plan 201 shall be re-named and known as St. Mary's Crescent.

10. All that portion of Lot 14, Concession 7 formerly in the Township of Tay now in the Village of Victoria Harbour and shown on Plan 51R-1413 as Jephson Street and / or Richard Street shall be re-named and known as St. Mary's Crescent.

11. All that portion of John Street as shown in Registered Plan 201 lying between the easterly extension of Ellen Street and the westerly limit of Victoria Street shall be re-named and known as Lumber Road.

12. All that portion of King Street as shown in Registered Plan 201 and lying between the southerly limit of Midland Street and the northerly limit of the Station Grounds shall be re-named and known as Pine Street.

13. All the portion of Queen Street as shown on Registered Plan 201 lying between the southerly limit of Midland Street in the northerly limit of the Station Grounds shall be re-named and known as Spruce Street.

14. All that portion of William Street as shown in Registered Plan 201 lying between the West limit of Victoria Street in the easterly limit of King Street shall be known as Cedar Street.

15. All that portion of the original Township road allowance lying between Concession 6 and 7 and lying northerly of William Street as produced westerly from the westerly limit of Registered Plan 201 shall be known as Georgian Drive.

16. All that part of Elizabeth Street as shown on Registered Plan 201 from the intersection of Elizabeth and Albert Streets easterly 192 feet in

24. All that part of Albert Street as shown on Registered Plan 861 lying Northerly of the extension westerly of the southerly boundary of Lot 34 shall be re-named and known as Eplett's Common.

25. All that part of Parkview Street as shown on Registered Plan 586 lying westerly of the Grand Trunk Railway right-of-way shall be re-named and known as Industrial Road.

26. The whole of Lovejoy Street as shown on Registered Plans 483 and 545 shall be re-named and known as Ivy Lane.

27. The whole of Ellen Street as shown on Registered Plan 545 shall be re-named and known as Trillium Street.

28. All that portion of the Station Grounds, railway lanes, Lot 24 East of Richard Street and Victoria Street all according to Registered Plan 201 and that part of the East half of Lot 14, Concession 7 formerly in the Township of Tay now in the Village of Victoria Harbour more particularly described in a Schedule and shown on a sketch posted in the offices of the Village of Victoria Harbour shall be re-named and known as Richard Street.

29. The whole of Lot 9, on the south side of Jephson Street according to Registered Plan 201 shall become known as MacKenzie Street.

30. The Northerly 150 feet of perpendicular width throughout Francis Street as shown on Registered Plan 201 shall become known as Lily's Common.

31. All that portion of a trespass road known as William Street and as shown on Registered Plan 475 lying west of the extension southerly of the easterly boundary of Lot 13 according to said Registered Plan 475 and extending westerly in front of Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 according to said Registered Plan 475 to the westerly terminus thereof shall be re-named and known as Sunset Place.
