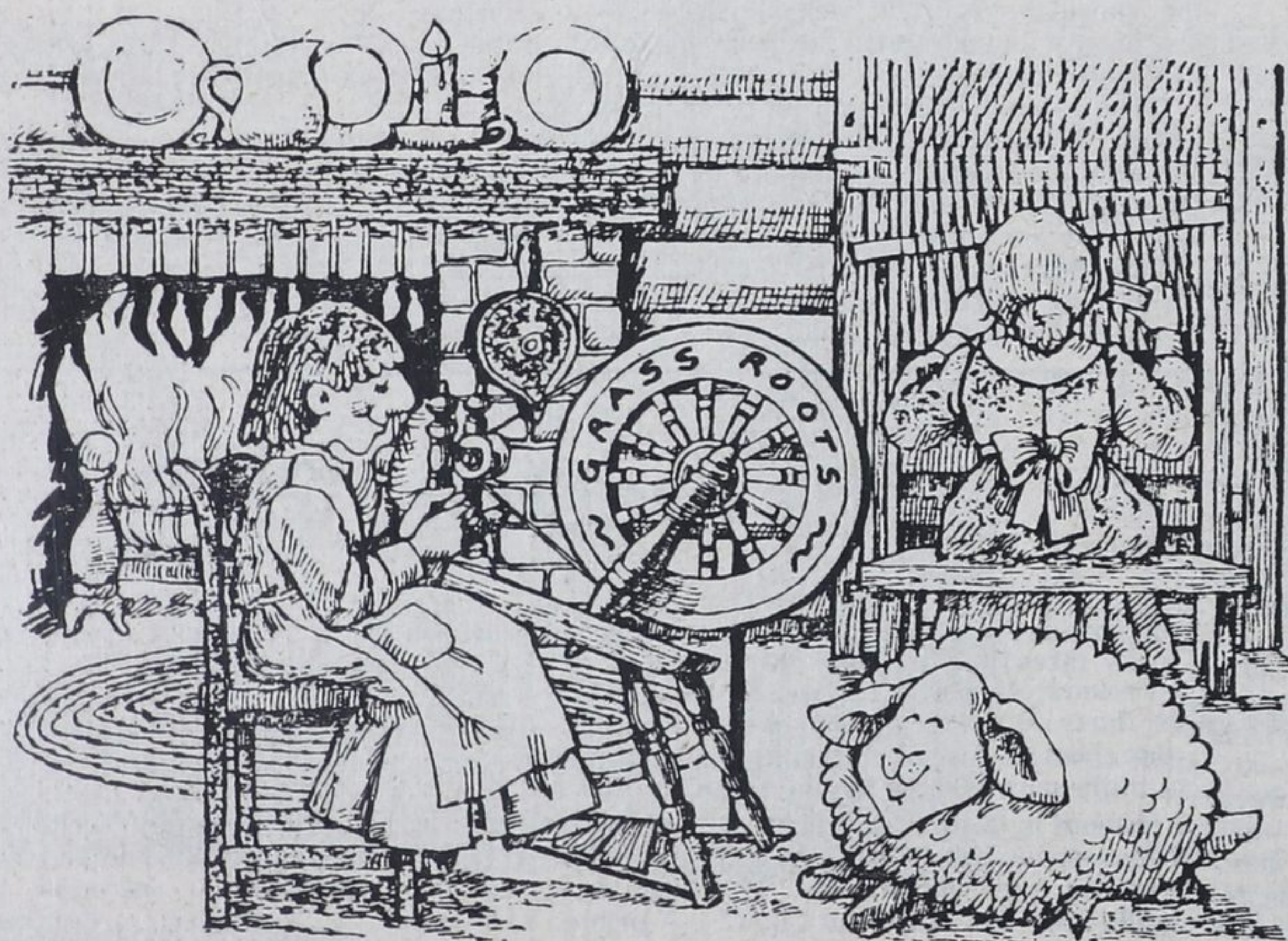
So the response we received and the actual turnout of new volunteers for our Big Brother for a Day event was really encouraging and heart-warming.
