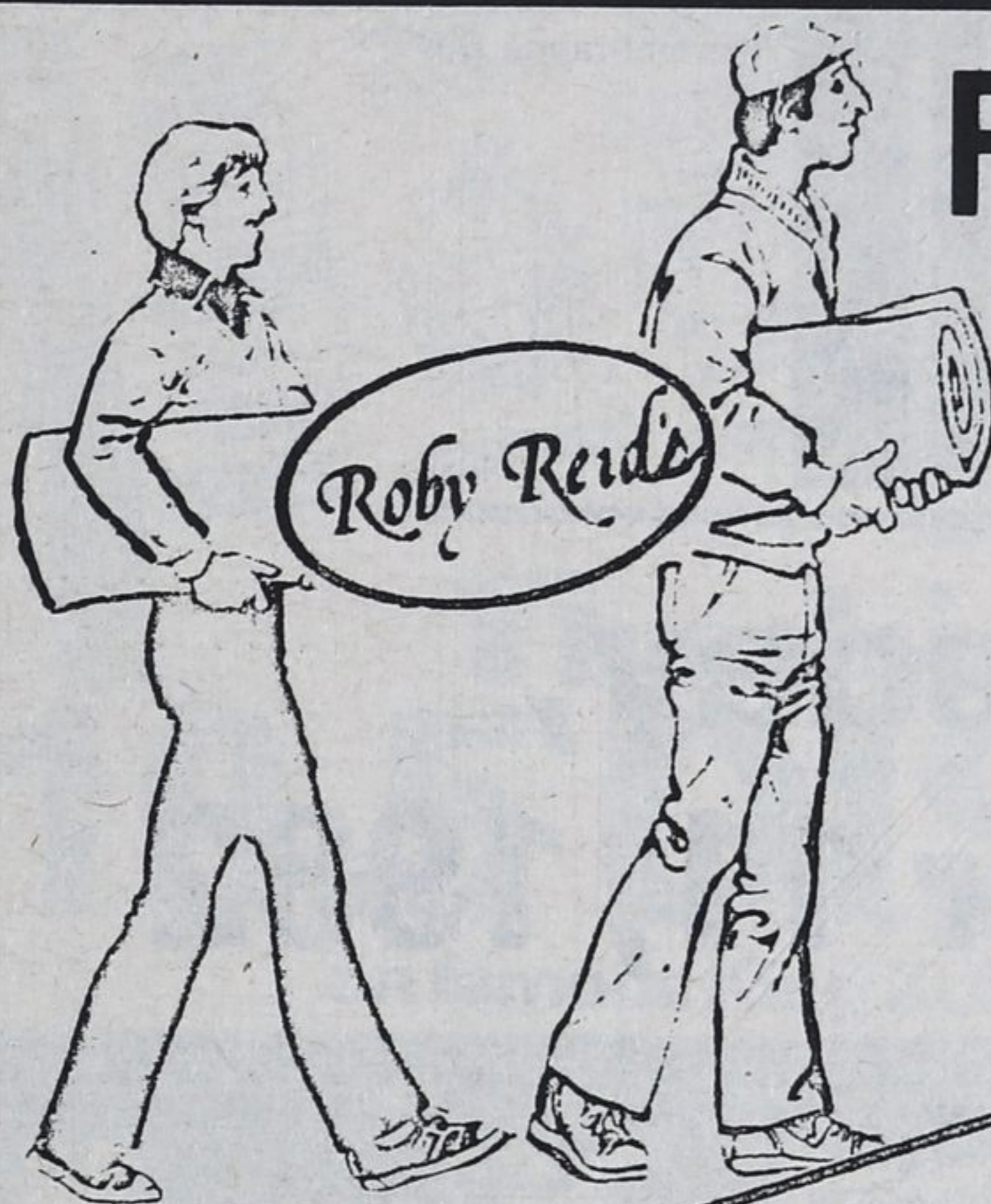


Diabetes branch gathering

Thursday, November 11.

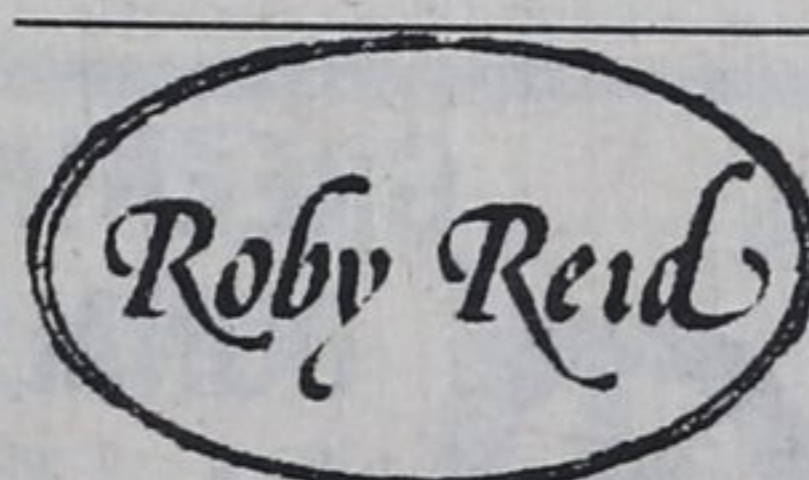
Parade will move off at 10:30 a.m. from Clubhouse for 11:00 a.m. Service at Cenotaph.
