

## Day Specialties puts Midland on the map

Day Specialties Co. Ltd., of Midland, recently won top honors in international screen printing competition for producing work that meets the highest standards of "quality and excellence."

According to John M. Crawford, executive vice-president of the Screen Printing Association International in Fairfax, Virginia, Daysco was presented Gold Squeegee award in the category of Flat Glass, Multi-color, during Screen Print '82, the industries annual international convention and exposition held Oct. 27-30, in Atlanta, Georgia.

Crawford further stated, "That the third annual "Golden Squeegee" Awards Competition was very competitive as we had more than 1,600 separate entries from companies around the world."

The part submitted was a 5mm thick tempered glass panel for a Kenmore kitchen range in the U.S. Daysco made 11 prints on the panel using semi-automatic screen presses.

The colors were produced with solvent based epoxy and ceramic inks screened through monofilament polyester fabrics from 125 to 330 mesh. Special features were a three color 75 line woodgrain and transparent tin oxide conductive film.

Day Specialties was founded in Midland in 1966. Daysco has been a member of SPAI since 1981 and specializes in decorated and tempered flat glass products mainly for the appliance industries.

Screen printing is an integral part of the graphic arts and is a leading production medium for point-of-purchase advertising, banners, decals, container decorating, circuitry, displays, billboards, felt markings, nameplates, T-shirts, ceramics, yard and piece goods, textiles, outdoor signs, dials, instrumentation, industrial markings, heat transfers, greeting cards, advertising specialties etc. Screen printing represents a multibillion-dollar industry.

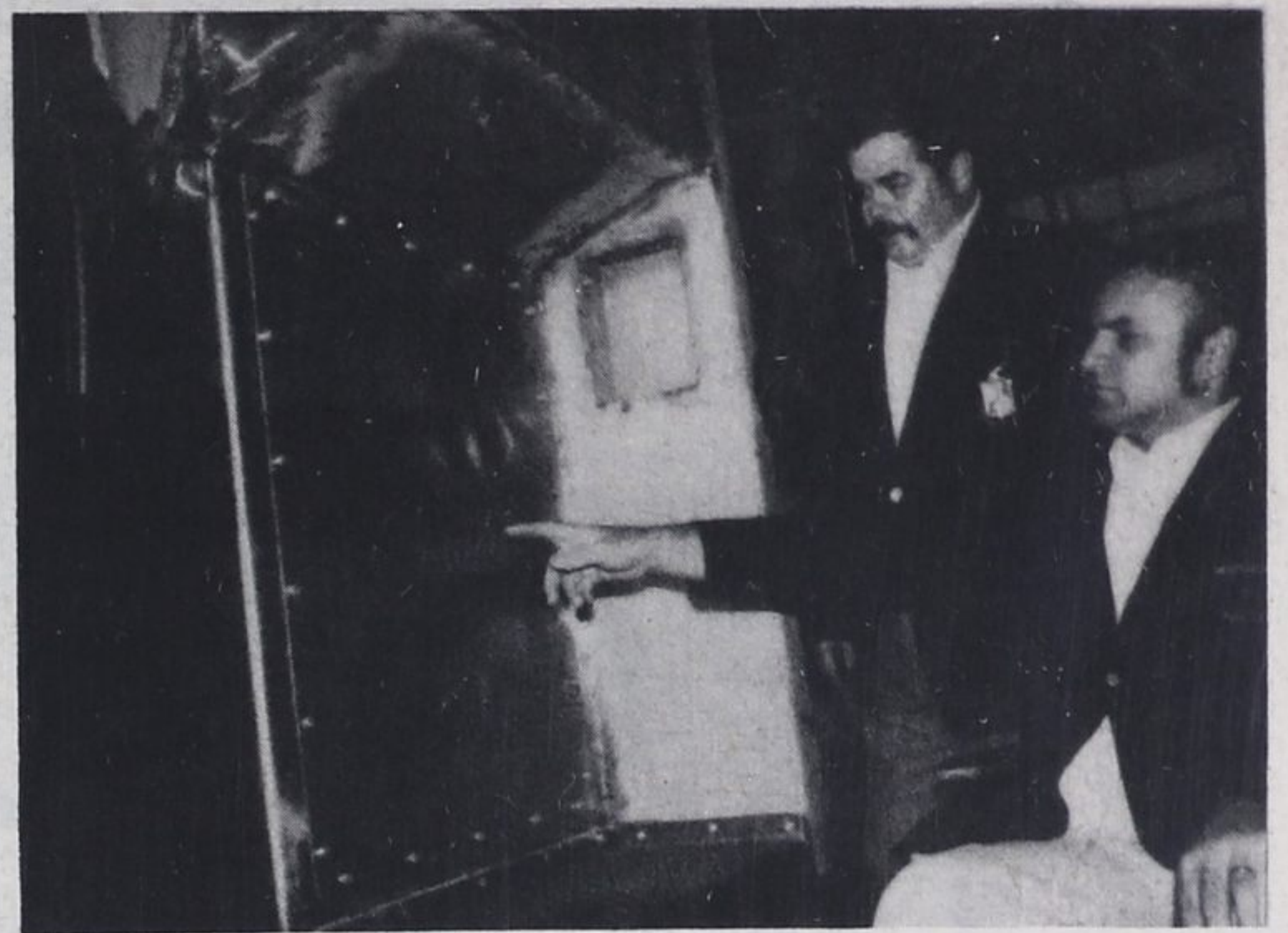
The Hereford Show, scheduled for 8:30 a.m., Monday, Nov. 15, has drawn 167 entries from across Canada.

Born in Arris, Ont., Dunbar has been untiring in his efforts to promote the Hereford breed. A former director of the Canadian Hereford Association, he served as president of the Association in 1956 and was a Canadian delegate at the third World Hereford Con-

ference in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

He is a past president of the Ontario Hereford Association and held the position of secretary-treasurer from 1963 to 1981. He was named to the first Canadian Hereford Honour Roll in 1975.

The National M.O.E. Hereford Show is to be judged by a second generation Hereford breeder, Neil Reavie, owner of Elzevir Herefords, Flinton, Ont. A top Canadian showman, Mr. Reavie has shown a Royal Grand Champion as well as an Agribition Junior Champion. He is president of the Ontario Polled Hereford Club and a past director of the Ontario Hereford Association.
