Tomorrow is Remembrance Day. Last Sunday, members of Midland Legion Branch 80 held their annual Remembrance Day Parade to Knox Presbyterian Church. The Legion's Pipes and Drums headed up the parade which it will again do tomorrow for the 11 a.m. service at the King Street Cenotaph.

\$163,167 grant county

Further acquisition and development of the Utopia Conservation Area, located approximately 16 km west of Barrie in the central part of Simcoe County, will be assisted by an Ontario grant of \$163,167.

In approving this project, Natural Resources Minister Alan Pope said that the recently approved master plan for this area will ensure that the goals of the Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority to conserve important valleylands along the Bear Creek and to provide low-intensity recreational opportunities for the residents of Simcoe County will be achieved.

Included in the Conservation Authority's longrange plan is the development of nature trails, improved picnicking and camping facilities, changeroom for swimmers, and erosion control works to reduce sedimentation and improve water quality. Also identified in the plan is the possible future acquisition of approximately 64 acres of additional valleyland, if and when such properties are offered for sale on the open market.

The approved master plan will be implemented over a period of approximately 20 years, as funding permits, at a total estimated cost of \$315,500.


