Hon. Jean Chretien, federal minister of energy and former minister of justice, will be attending a soiree in his honour in Midland, the evening of Friday, Dec. 3.

Billed as an evening with one of Canada's most senior cabinet ministers, the event at the Budd Watson Gallery is intended to be a fund-raiser of sorts for the Liberal Party in as much as it is to be hosted by the Simcoe North Liberal Association.

Tickets are \$100 apiece. You read correctly. The cost can be effectively reduced to \$40 through a

\$60 Federal Tax Credit. An official tax receipt will be issued during the "do."

The cocktail reception from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. will afford partisans the opportunity to meet Chretien, to sip on cocktails and munch on hor d'ouvres.

The Grits are quick to point out in their promotional material, "The informal get together will allow for a stimulating exchange of views and an opportunity for you or your firm to voice opinions directly to one of Canada's most senior ministers."
