The poinsettia

The poinsettia plant is a welcome addition in any home or business during the Christmas season and, for that matter, all year round.

The poinsettia received its name from diplomat Jel Roberts Poinsett, who first brought cuttings to the United States from

Mexico in the late 1820s. A general misconception about the plant concerns the red "blooms." These are not flowers at all. bracts that become colorful when exposed to sunlight. The actual flowers are tiny, yellow blossoms in the centre of the beautiful bracts. Another misunderstanding is the charge that the poinsettia is poisonous. Exhaustive research has proved beyond doubt that the poinsettia is non-toxic.

While red is the traditional poinsettia color, the plant is also available in white and shades of pink. Your retail florist may also be carrying some of the new two-toned varieties - white with pink and red with pink.

Poinsettias are grown distinct two categories. The "branched" plants are pinched short and full of blossoms - like a "bouquet." The "singlestem" varieties contain several individual plants in a pot - each bearing one larg bloom.

New to the market are poinsettias that cascade from hanging baskets

and plants sculpted to resemble topiary trees. Because of their novelty, your florist may have to specialorder these items.


