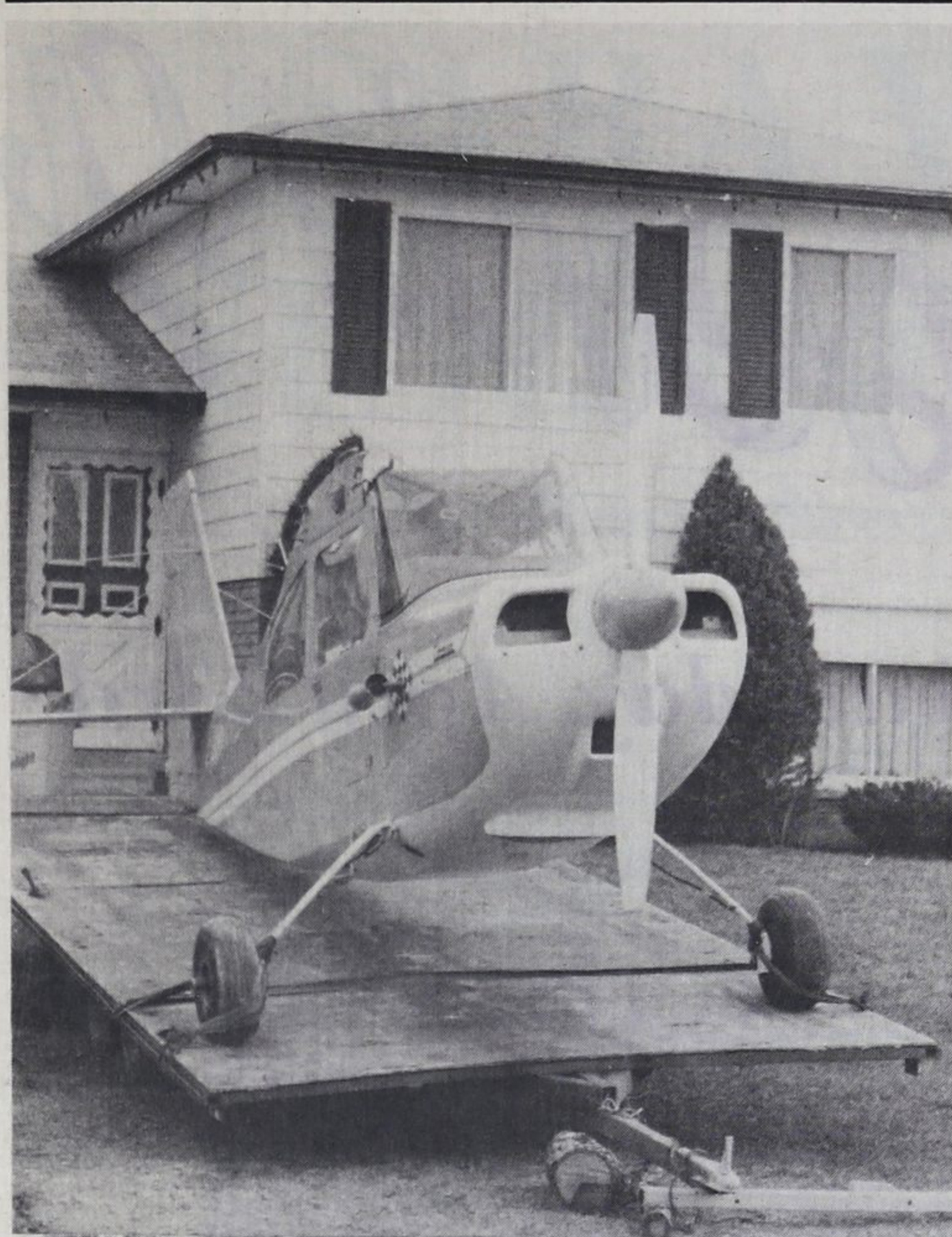


Council okays adding to Fire Department

Morgan Williams Jr. flew this Citabria aerobatic plane, seen wingless on his father's lawn on Glen Eagles Crescent, Midland, on the weekend, to a third place finish in the Aerobatics Canada Nationals in 1976 while he was still a student at Midland Secondary School.

Midland Fire Chief Hal Belfry, according to Mayor Al Roach, has been given the green light to hire a new full-time firefighter as quickly as possible.

The fire chief is also to prepare a report on the current compliment of full-time firefighters with a view to possibly adding to the department later this year.

At this time last year, in an economy move, the town laid off two permanent men. Since then former fire chief Terry Lethbridge has resigned, Adam Staruck has resigned and last Saturday long-time Midland firefighter "Mickey" McIntaggart passed away at HDH.

As for Firefighter McIntaggart's untimely death, Chief Belfry is quoted as saying, "He (McIntaggart) was a real asset to our department.

"He was always cheerful...and a real family man. Mickey will be greatly missed by all of us not only here at the

fire hall but throughout the town.

"We were shocked and saddened on Saturday to learn of his death. It was a blow to all of us. He was a most professional firefighter we'll all greatly miss. We just can't get over the shock of learning about his death."

The late Mickey McIntaggart served as president in 1980 of the Simcoe County Mutual Fire Aid Association.

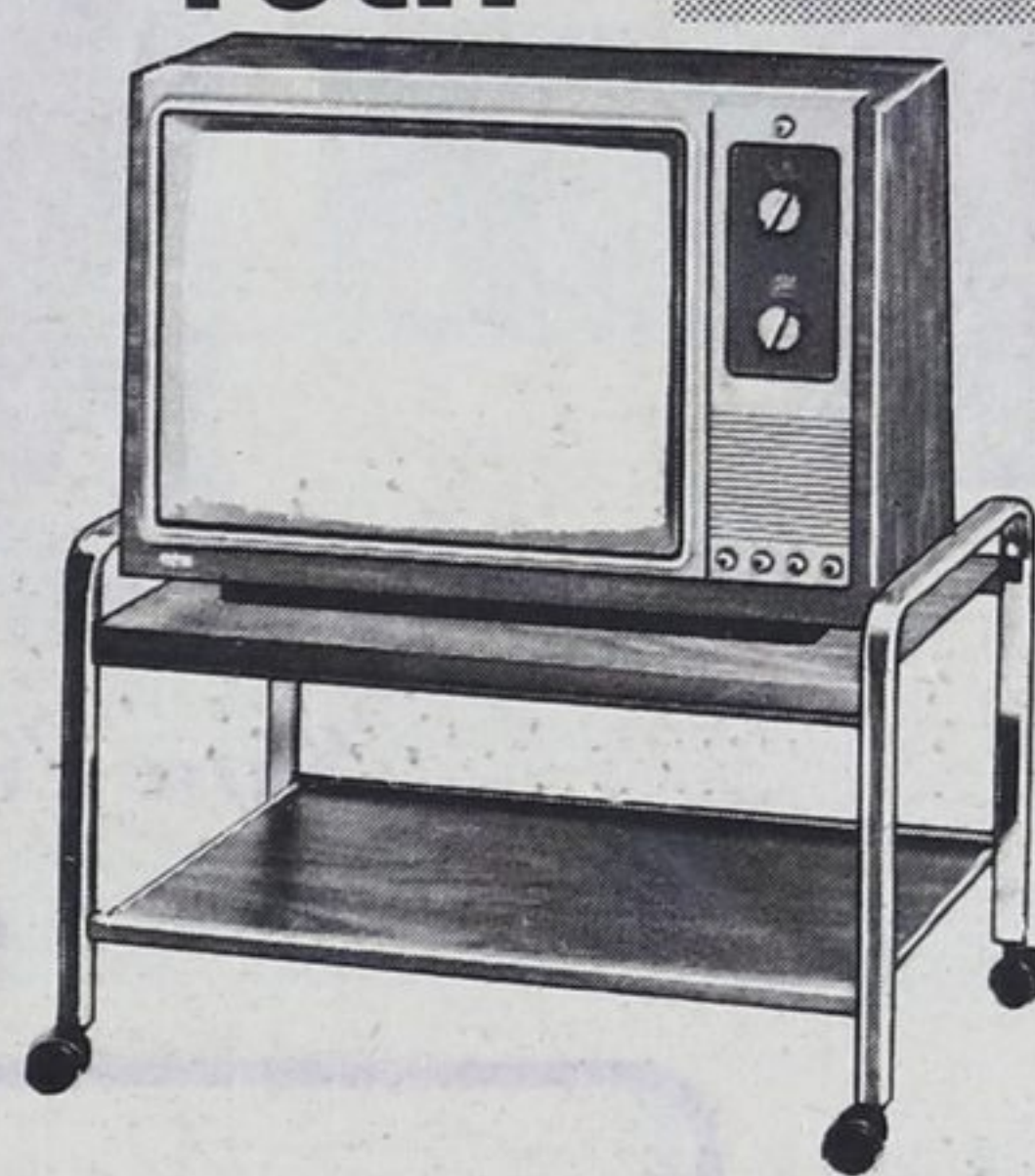
According to Belfry, "Mickey served in a variety of capacities on the executive of Local 1581 of the Ontario Association of Professional Firefighters from 1971 to 1982.

"He was the association's treasurer this year." The fire chief confessed, "It's just tough putting into words how we feel about Mickey's death...we are all saddened by it...that's all I can really say at this time..."

The decision to hire a new firefighter was approved during a special in-camera council meeting on Monday.

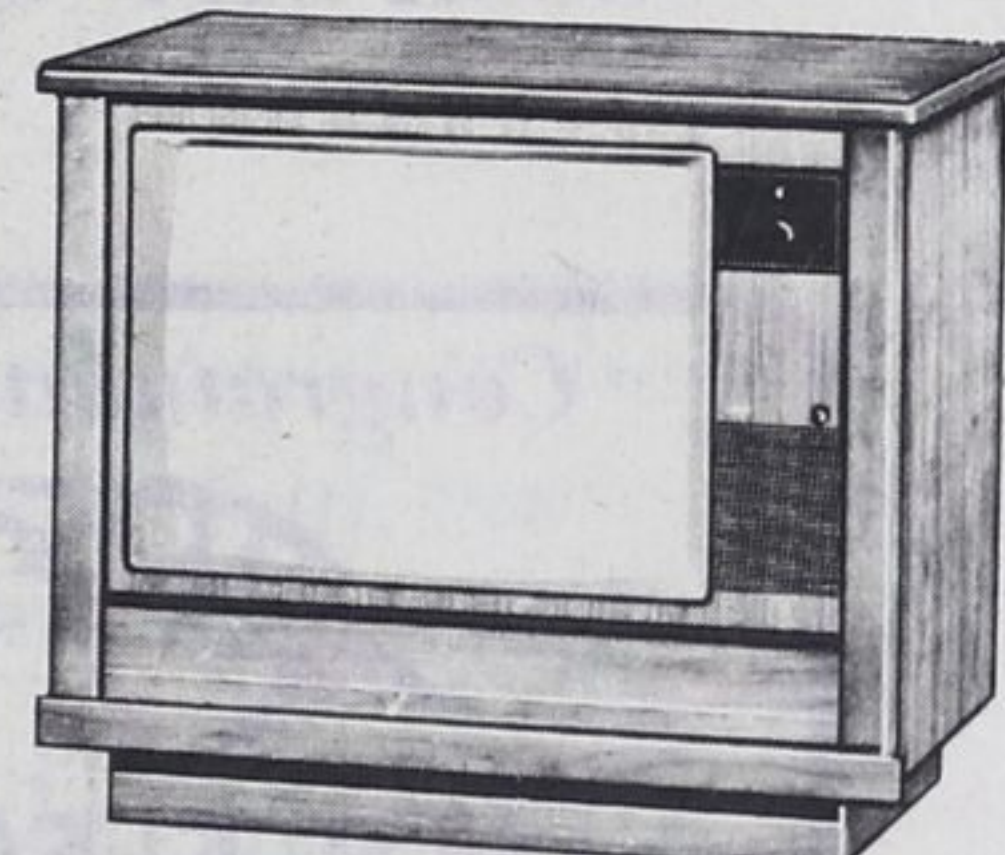
