# ESPSS shines at at Zone track

Penetanguishene Secondary School athletes made one of their best showings ever at the Zone II track and field championships in Orillia on Tuesday.

ESPSS qualified 28 athletes in 50 events for the Zone meet, and that was the best performance in school history. These athletes put on a quality show as well, with the boys' team finishing first overall and the girls finishing third.

In total points, ESPSS had 493 compared to Orillia District's 545. The boys accounted for 308, and the females came up with 185.

Among the top performers for ESPSS was the record-setting effort of Carrie Fedorowich in the junior girls' 80 metre hurdles. Carrie won the race in the record time of 13.22 seconds.

Other top showings included Mike Pilon's second place finish overall in the midget boys' division. Pilon gained that position by finishing first in the triple jump, second in the 100 metres, third in the 200 metres, and third in the long jump.

Beatty Spencer was third overall in the midget girls' division, by virtue of her second place finishes in the hurdles, 200 metres, and long jump, and her third in the 100 metres.

Suzanne Desroches was second overall in junior girls, as she won the 1500 and 3000 metre races, and was second in the 800 metres.

Denis Brunelle was second overall in the senior boys, as he finished first in the 100 and 200 metre dashes, second in the long jump, and third in the triple jump.

Brian Wagg was third in the same group, while finishing first in the discus, second in the shot put, and third in the 100 metres.

ESPSS swept the top three spots in the senior boys' 100 metre sprint. They also won the senior 4 x 100 relay, and the team was made up of Tom Rankin, Bruce McNee, Denis Brunelle, and Brian Wagg.

Finally, Penetang totally dominated the pole vault event in all age groups. They took five of the top six spots in the vault. Mark Cook won the midget, Kevin Wagg won the junior vault, with second place going to David Hornburg, and Tim Spicer won the senior event, with Greg Brunelle second.

Next target for the ESPSS Redskins track and field squad is next Thursday's Georgian Bay championships to be held at the beautiful York University track facility.


