
Jeffery hopes deputy can be hired from ranks

Midland Fire Department is in the market for a new deputy fire chief.

With this in mind, the town's public safety committee (under the chairmanship of Alderman Bob Jeffery) gave Fire Chief Hal Belfry the green light to advertise the position "in-house."

Alderman Jeffery hopes a new deputy fire chief can be hired within the ranks of the present full-time firefighters.

If this is accomplished, it will leave a vacancy on the floor which Jeffery hopes then can be filled by former Midland firefighter Tom Toole who was laid off more than a year ago by the town in an economy move.

At that time both Toole and firefighter. Jim Ironside were let go. Since then Ironside has been rehired after the department found itself short of fulltime firefighters when Adam Staruck retired, former fire chief Terry Lethbridge resigned and long-time Midland Mickey firefighter McIntaggart passed away several weeks ago.

Midland law-makers plan to hold their next public session on Monday, June 13, however Alderman Jeffery, a former Midland firefighter himself, told The Times yesterday "we hope to have the new deputy fire chief picked by then."






